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## **HOUSE BILL No. 5260**

October 6, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Murphy, Whitmer and Byrum and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

(MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding section 683a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 683A. THE STATE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT SHALL ERECT, OR
- 2 CAUSE TO BE ERECTED, A TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT THE INTERSECTION OF NORTH
- 3 FAIRVIEW AVENUE AND SAGINAW HIGHWAY IN THE CITY OF LANSING.
- 4 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 5 unless approved by a majority of the voters of the city of Lansing
- 6 voting on the question. The question of the adoption of this
  - amendatory act shall be submitted to the voters of the city of
  - Lansing at the next regular election to be held not less than 60
- 9 days after the effective date of this amendatory act or at a
  - special election called for that purpose. The question shall be

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- 1 submitted in substantially the following form:
- 2 "Shall 2006 Local Act \_\_\_\_, to amend the Michigan vehicle code
- 3 to require the erection of a traffic signal at the intersection of
- 4 North Fairview Avenue and Saginaw Highway in the city of Lansing,
- **5** be adopted?
- **6** Yes ( )
- 7 No ()".
- 8 The result of the vote shall be canvassed by the board of
- 9 state canvassers. If a majority of the electors voting on the
- 10 question vote in favor of the adoption of this amendatory act, it
- 11 shall take effect 10 days following the certification of the
- 12 election results.
