THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 4CC. (1) A PERSON SUBJECT TO TAX UNDER THIS ACT MAY
- 2 EXCLUDE FROM GROSS PROCEEDS USED FOR THE COMPUTATION OF THE TAX THE
- 3 SALE OF A QUALIFIED HOME APPLIANCE. AS USED IN THIS SECTION,
- 4 "QUALIFIED HOME APPLIANCE" MEANS A CLOTHES WASHER, DEHUMIDIFIER,
- 5 REFRIGERATOR, DISHWASHER, FREEZER, ROOM AIR CONDITIONER, AIR
- 6 CLEANER, OR WATER COOLER THAT MEETS OR EXCEEDS THE APPLICABLE
- 7 ENERGY STAR ENERGY EFFICIENCY GUIDELINES DEVELOPED BY THE UNITED
- 8 STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY AND THE UNITED STATES
- 9 DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY.

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- 1 (2) NOT LATER THAN JANUARY 1 EACH YEAR, THE STATE TREASURER
- 2 SHALL DETERMINE THE AMOUNT OF REVENUE LOST FROM THE STATE SCHOOL
- 3 AID FUND IN THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING STATE FISCAL YEAR BECAUSE OF
- 4 THE EXEMPTION IN THIS SECTION AND SHALL IMMEDIATELY DEPOSIT THAT
- 5 AMOUNT FROM THE STATE GENERAL FUND INTO THE STATE SCHOOL AID FUND.
