

HOUSE BILL No. 5523

December 14, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Gosselin, Drolet, Marleau, Hoogendyk, Baxter, Shaffer, Steil, Garfield, Acciavatti, Mortimer, Sheen, Stahl, Pastor, Palmer and Schuitmaker and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1984 PA 431, entitled
"The management and budget act,"
by amending section 213 (MCL 18.1213).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 213. (1) As used in this section:

2 (a) "Fund" means the motor transport revolving fund created in
3 subsection (4).

4 (b) "Motor vehicle" means a passenger vehicle, van, minibus,
5 bus, truck, tractor, or other motorized vehicle.

6 (2) The department may issue directives relative to all the
7 following for motor vehicles except for those motor vehicles under
8 the jurisdiction of the state transportation department:

9 (a) The purchasing, leasing, maintaining, operating,

1 replacing, and disposing of motor vehicles for all state agencies.

2 (b) The using of state owned motor vehicles for official
3 business.

4 (c) The establishing of conditions for use of privately owned
5 motor vehicles on official business.

6 (d) The acquiring of vehicle registration plates.

7 (e) The maintaining of motor vehicle titles and insurance
8 inventories.

9 (f) The assigning of motor vehicles, permanently or
10 temporarily, to state agencies and to institutions of higher
11 education.

12 (g) The establishing of rates to be charged for use of a motor
13 vehicle. The rates shall be reviewed periodically and shall be
14 sufficient to cover the costs of administration and of the
15 acquisition, operation, maintenance, repair, and replacement of
16 motor vehicles.

17 (h) The displaying of distinctive vehicle registration plates
18 and other external markings on the motor vehicles. The plates and
19 markings shall clearly identify state ownership unless the motor
20 vehicle is used by an elected official, or for an investigative
21 use, or anonymity is essential to properly perform a necessary
22 function of state government as determined by the director.

23 (3) The department shall establish motor vehicle repair
24 centers and motor pools.

25 (4) The motor transport revolving fund is hereby created. The
26 revenue received from rates charged pursuant to subsection (2)(g)
27 and revenue ~~which~~ **THAT** is received from any other source and

1 designated to be credited to the motor transport revolving fund
2 shall be credited to the motor transport revolving fund. The
3 amounts in the fund are continuously appropriated only for
4 administration and the acquisition, lease, operation, maintenance,
5 repair, and replacement of state owned motor vehicles and related
6 capital outlay and equipment.

7 (5) Assets and liabilities of the motor transport revolving
8 fund shall be considered assets and liabilities of the motor
9 transport revolving fund created by this section.

10 (6) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CREATE AND MAINTAIN A RECORD OF
11 INFORMATION CONCERNING EACH MOTOR VEHICLE OWNED OR LEASED BY A
12 STATE AGENCY AND MAKE THAT INFORMATION AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC BY
13 POSTING IT ON A WEBSITE THAT THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH AND
14 MAINTAIN FOR THAT PURPOSE. THE INFORMATION IN THE RECORD SHALL
15 INCLUDE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING THAT APPLY:

16 (A) THE PURCHASE DATE OR INITIAL LEASE DATE AND DURATION OF
17 THE LEASE.

18 (B) IF A MOTOR VEHICLE IS SOLD, THE DATE OF SALE.

19 (C) THE YEAR, MAKE, AND MODEL OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE.

20 (D) THE DEPARTMENT OR STATE AGENCY AND SUPERVISOR WITH CHARGE
21 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE.

22 (E) THE NAME OF ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO IS AUTHORIZED TO USE THE
23 MOTOR VEHICLE.

24 (F) THE MILEAGE TRAVELED BY THE MOTOR VEHICLE DURING THE
25 IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING FISCAL YEAR OR PORTION OF THE FISCAL YEAR
26 DURING WHICH THE MOTOR VEHICLE WAS OWNED OR UNDER LEASE.

27 (G) THE TOTAL MILEAGE ON THE MOTOR VEHICLE.

1 (7) NOT LATER THAN JANUARY 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT
2 SHALL POST THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION ON THE DEPARTMENT'S WEBSITE IN
3 THE SAME MANNER AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (6):

4 (A) INFORMATION PROVIDED BY A CITY, VILLAGE, TOWNSHIP, OR
5 COUNTY TO THE DEPARTMENT UNDER SECTION 20A OF THE GLENN STEIL STATE
6 REVENUE SHARING ACT OF 1971, 1971 PA 140, MCL 141.920A.

7 (B) INFORMATION PROVIDED BY A DISTRICT OR INTERMEDIATE
8 DISTRICT UNDER SECTION 164F OF THE STATE SCHOOL AID ACT OF 1979,
9 1979 PA 94, MCL 388.1764F.
