## **HOUSE BILL No. 5628**

February 1, 2006, Introduced by Reps. Casperson, Emmons, Marleau, Vander Veen and Farhat and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Forestry, and Outdoor Recreation.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled

"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"

by amending section 50507 (MCL 324.50507), as amended by 2004 PA 124.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 50507. (1) The authority shall finance only forest
- 2 management operations and practices consistent with part 525 that
- 3 follow the guidelines, rules, and objectives prescribed and
- 4 approved by the department as these guidelines, rules, and
- 5 objectives are amended by the department.
  - (2) Funds managed by the authority shall be applied in a

- 1 manner consistent with part 525 and the land management planning
- 2 policies of the department on lands that have been identified for
- 3 forest management practices. In the absence of an approved state
- 4 forest management plan covering a candidate area, an interim
- 5 procedure, as adopted by the department, shall be used to assure
- 6 that all forest values have been considered in selecting sites for
- 7 investment with funds of the authority. The department shall
- 8 annually submit a list of activities and practices allocated from
- 9 the funds generated under this part for the board's review and
- 10 determination of consistency with the purposes of this part.
- 11 (3) The executive director of the authority shall notify the
- 12 department if the authority projects a probable default on any
- 13 bonds or notes issued by the authority, and within 1 year of
- 14 receipt of the notification, or within less than 1 year, if the
- 15 notification indicates a shorter time period is necessary to avoid
- 16 a default, the department shall identify and convey to the
- 17 authority sufficient timber on tax reverted lands to enable the
- 18 authority to avoid the projected default and to provide for timely
- 19 payment of principal of and interest on the authority's bonds or
- 20 notes. The authority may only issue contracts for the cutting and
- 21 sale of timber that has been conveyed to the authority under this
- 22 section to avoid a default on any bonds or notes issued by the
- 23 authority. The determination of the board as to the need to cut and
- 24 sell timber is conclusive. Contracts for the cutting and sale of
- 25 timber shall be consistent with part 525 and with the guidelines,
- 26 rules, and objectives prescribed by the department.
- 27 (4) The authority shall establish a fund designated as the

- 1 "forest development fund". Any money on hand or received in the
- 2 future from bond proceeds and from contracts for the cutting and
- 3 sale of timber on tax reverted lands shall be deposited in the
- 4 forest development fund. In addition, this fund may receive
- 5 revenues from any other source. The authority shall use money in
- 6 the forest development fund for 1 or more of the following AS
- 7 FOLLOWS:
- 8 (A) IN EACH STATE FISCAL YEAR, MONEY RECEIVED BY THE FUND FROM
- 9 THE PROCEEDS OF THE SALE OF THE FIRST 90,000 CORDS OF WOOD
- 10 HARVESTED FROM THE STATE FOREST SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED AS FOLLOWS:
- 11 (i) FIFTY PERCENT OF THE MONEY SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE
- 12 SCHOOL AID FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER SECTION 11 OF ARTICLE IX OF THE
- 13 STATE CONSTITUTION OF 1963.
- 14 (ii) FIFTY PERCENT OF THE MONEY SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED TO EACH
- 15 LOCAL TAX COLLECTING UNIT IN EACH COUNTY THAT HAS LAND CLASSIFIED
- 16 AS COMMERCIAL FOREST UNDER PART 511 IN PROPORTION TO THE AMOUNT OF
- 17 COMMERCIAL FORESTLAND IN THAT LOCAL TAX COLLECTING UNIT, TO BE
- 18 DISTRIBUTED IN THE SAME MANNER AND IN THE SAME PROPORTION AS AD
- 19 VALOREM TAXES COLLECTED UNDER THE GENERAL PROPERTY TAX ACT, 1893 PA
- 20 206, MCL 211.1 TO 211.157.
- 21 (B) AFTER MONEY IS DISTRIBUTED UNDER SUBDIVISION (A), MONEY IN
- 22 THE FUND SHALL BE EXPENDED AS FOLLOWS:
- 23 (i) -(a) To provide for the payment of principal of and
- 24 interest on any bonds or notes issued by the authority.
- 25 ( $\ddot{u}$ ) —(b)— For reforestation, forest protection, and timber
- 26 stand improvement.
- 27 (iii) —(e)— To obtain and maintain certification of sustainable

- 1 forestry standards in the state forest under section 52505.
- 2 (iv) -(d) For any other purposes authorized by this part.
- 3 (5) The auditor general shall audit the expenditures of the
- 4 forest development fund at least once every 3 years.
- 5 (6) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "STATE FOREST" MEANS THAT TERM AS
- 6 IT IS DEFINED IN SECTION 52501.
- 7 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 8 unless House Bill No. 5453 of the 93rd Legislature is enacted into
- 9 law.
