## **HOUSE BILL No. 5790**

March 1, 2006, Introduced by Rep. Moolenaar and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1979 PA 94, entitled

"The state school aid act of 1979,"

by amending section 11 (MCL 388.1611), as amended by 2005 PA 155.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 11. (1) For the fiscal year ending September 30, 2005, 1 2 there is appropriated for the public schools of this state and 3 certain other state purposes relating to education the sum of \$10,907,222,200.00 from the state school aid fund established by 4 5 section 11 of article IX of the state constitution of 1963, the sum 6 of \$41,100,000.00 from the proceeds of capitalization of the school bond loan fund revolving fund, and the sum of \$165,200,000.00 from 7 the general fund. For the fiscal year ending September 30, 2006, there is appropriated for the public schools of this state and

- 1 certain other state purposes relating to education the sum of
- 2 \$11,257,600,000.00 from the state school aid fund established by
- 3 section 11 of article IX of the state constitution of 1963, the sum
- 4 of \$44,500,000.00 from the proceeds of capitalization of the school
- 5 bond loan fund revolving fund, and the sum of \$62,714,000.00 from
- 6 the general fund. FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2007,
- 7 THERE IS APPROPRIATED FOR THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF THIS STATE AND
- 8 CERTAIN OTHER STATE PURPOSES RELATING TO EDUCATION THE SUM OF
- 9 \$\_\_\_\_\_ FROM THE STATE SCHOOL AID FUND ESTABLISHED BY
- 10 SECTION 11 OF ARTICLE IX OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION OF 1963 AND THE
- 11 SUM OF \$\_\_\_\_\_ FROM THE GENERAL FUND. In addition,
- 12 available federal funds are appropriated for each fiscal year.
- 13 (2) The appropriations under this section shall be allocated
- 14 as provided in this act. Money appropriated under this section from
- 15 the general fund shall be expended to fund the purposes of this act
- 16 before the expenditure of money appropriated under this section
- 17 from the state school aid fund. If the maximum amount appropriated
- 18 under this section from the state school aid fund for a fiscal year
- 19 exceeds the amount necessary to fully fund allocations under this
- 20 act from the state school aid fund, that excess amount shall not be
- 21 expended in that state fiscal year and shall not lapse to the
- 22 general fund, but instead shall be deposited into the school aid
- 23 stabilization fund created in section 11a.
- 24 (3) If the maximum amount appropriated under this section from
- 25 the state school aid fund and the school aid stabilization fund for
- 26 a fiscal year exceeds the amount available for expenditure from the
- 27 state school aid fund for that fiscal year, payments under sections

- 1 11f, 11g, 11j, 22a, 26a, 26b, 31d, 51a(2), 51a(12), 51c, 53a, and
- 2 56 shall be made in full. In addition, for districts beginning
- 3 operations after 1994-95 that qualify for payments under section
- 4 22b, payments under section 22b shall be made so that the
- 5 qualifying districts receive the lesser of an amount equal to the
- 6 1994-95 foundation allowance of the district in which the district
- 7 beginning operations after 1994-95 is located or \$5,500.00. The
- 8 amount of the payment to be made under section 22b for these
- 9 qualifying districts shall be as calculated under section 22a, with
- 10 the balance of the payment under section 22b being subject to the
- 11 proration otherwise provided under this subsection and subsection
- 12 (4). If proration is necessary after 2002-2003, state payments
- 13 under each of the other sections of this act from all state funding
- 14 sources shall be prorated in the manner prescribed in subsection
- 15 (4) as necessary to reflect the amount available for expenditure
- 16 from the state school aid fund for the affected fiscal year.
- 17 However, if the department of treasury determines that proration
- 18 will be required under this subsection, or if the department of
- 19 treasury determines that further proration is required under this
- 20 subsection after an initial proration has already been made for a
- 21 fiscal year, the department of treasury shall notify the state
- 22 budget director, and the state budget director shall notify the
- 23 legislature at least 30 calendar days or 6 legislative session
- 24 days, whichever is more, before the department reduces any payments
- 25 under this act because of the proration. During the 30 calendar day
- 26 or 6 legislative session day period after that notification by the
- 27 state budget director, the department shall not reduce any payments

- 1 under this act because of proration under this subsection. The
- 2 legislature may prevent proration from occurring by, within the 30
- 3 calendar day or 6 legislative session day period after that
- 4 notification by the state budget director, enacting legislation
- 5 appropriating additional funds from the general fund,
- 6 countercyclical budget and economic stabilization fund, state
- 7 school aid fund balance, or another source to fund the amount of
- 8 the projected shortfall.
- 9 (4) If proration is necessary, the department shall calculate
- 10 the proration in district and intermediate district payments that
- 11 is required under subsection (3) as follows:
- 12 (a) The department shall calculate the percentage of total
- 13 state school aid allocated under this act for the affected fiscal
- 14 year for each of the following:
- 15 (i) Districts.
- 16 (ii) Intermediate districts.
- 17 (iii) Entities other than districts or intermediate districts.
- 18 (b) The department shall recover a percentage of the proration
- 19 amount required under subsection (3) that is equal to the
- 20 percentage calculated under subdivision (a)(i) for districts by
- 21 reducing payments to districts. This reduction shall be made by
- 22 calculating an equal dollar amount per pupil as necessary to
- 23 recover this percentage of the proration amount and reducing each
- 24 district's total state school aid from state sources, other than
- 25 payments under sections 11f, 11g, 11j, 22a, 26a, 26b, 31d, 51a(2),
- 26 51a(12), 51c, and 53a, by that amount.
- (c) The department shall recover a percentage of the proration

- 1 amount required under subsection (3) that is equal to the
- 2 percentage calculated under subdivision (a)(ii) for intermediate
- 3 districts by reducing payments to intermediate districts. This
- 4 reduction shall be made by reducing the payments to each
- 5 intermediate district, other than payments under sections 11f, 11g,
- 6 26a, 26b, 51a(2), 51a(12), 53a, and 56, on an equal percentage
- 7 basis.
- 8 (d) The department shall recover a percentage of the proration
- 9 amount required under subsection (3) that is equal to the
- 10 percentage calculated under subdivision (a)(iii) for entities other
- 11 than districts and intermediate districts by reducing payments to
- 12 these entities. This reduction shall be made by reducing the
- 13 payments to each of these entities, other than payments under
- 14 sections 11j, 26a, and 26b, on an equal percentage basis.
- 15 (5) Except for the allocation under section 26a, any general
- 16 fund allocations under this act that are not expended by the end of
- 17 the state fiscal year are transferred to the school aid
- 18 stabilization fund created under section 11a.
