

HOUSE BILL No. 5892

March 16, 2006, Introduced by Reps. Hildenbrand, Elsenheimer, Acciavatti, Kahn, Nitz, Baxter, Farhat, Miller, Bieda, Mortimer and Taub and referred to the Committee on House Oversight, Elections, and Ethics.

A bill to provide for submitting the question of whether to call a constitutional convention to the electors of this state.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. (1) At the 2006 general November election, the
2 question of whether to call a constitutional convention to draft a
3 general revision of the state constitution of 1963 shall be
4 submitted to the electors of this state. The question submitted to
5 the electors shall be substantially as follows:

6 "Shall a convention of elected delegates be convened to draft
7 a general revision of the state constitution of 1963 for
8 presentation to the state's electors for their approval or
9 rejection?

2 (2) If a majority of electors approve the question presented
3 in subsection (1), a constitutional convention shall be called in
4 accordance with section 3 of article XII of the state constitution
5 of 1963.
