A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 135a.

- 2 (B) IF THE VIOLATION RESULTS IN PHYSICAL HARM OTHER THAN

- 4 MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR
- 5 A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000.00, OR BOTH.
- 6 (C) IF THE VIOLATION RESULTS IN SERIOUS PHYSICAL HARM TO THE

- 10 (D) IF THE VIOLATION RESULTS IN THE DEATH OF THE CHILD, THE
- 11 PERSON IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT
- 12 MORE THAN 15 YEARS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$10,000.00, OR BOTH.

- 14 (A) "CHILD" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL LESS THAN 6 YEARS OF AGE.
- 15 (B) "PHYSICAL HARM" AND "SERIOUS PHYSICAL HARM" MEAN THOSE
- 16 TERMS AS DEFINED IN SECTION 136B.
- 17 (C) "UNATTENDED" MEANS ALONE OR WITHOUT THE SUPERVISION OF AN
- 18 INDIVIDUAL 13 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER WHO IS NOT LEGALLY
- 19 INCAPACITATED.
- 20 (D) "VEHICLE" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 79 OF THE
- 21 MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.79.
