THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 32713. (1) The department may request the attorney
- 2 general to commence a civil action for appropriate relief,
- 3 including a permanent or temporary injunction, for a violation of
- 4 this part or a rule promulgated under this part. An action under
- 5 this section shall be brought in the circuit court for the county
- 6 of Ingham or for the county in which the defendant is located,
- 7 resides, or is doing business. The court has jurisdiction to
 - restrain the violation and to require compliance.

- 1 (2) In addition to any other relief granted UNDER THIS
- 2 SECTION, the court may impose a civil fine AS FOLLOWS:
