## **HOUSE BILL No. 6133**

June 1, 2006, Introduced by Reps. Nofs, Taub, Tobocman, Vagnozzi, Espinoza, Sheltrown, Schuitmaker, Elsenheimer, Ward, Stahl, Proos, Mortimer, Ball, Nitz and Kooiman and referred to the Committee on House Oversight, Elections, and Ethics.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 388, entitled

"Michigan campaign finance act,"

by amending section 47 (MCL 169.247), as amended by 2001 PA 250, and by adding section 48.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 47. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection
- 2 and subject to subsections (3) and (4), a billboard, placard,
- 3 poster, pamphlet, or other printed matter having reference to an
- 4 election, a candidate, or a ballot question, shall bear upon it the
- 5 name and address of the person paying for the matter. Except as

  - (3) and (4), if the printed matter relating to a candidate is an

- 1 independent expenditure that is not authorized in writing by the
- 2 candidate committee of that candidate, the printed matter shall
- 3 contain the following disclaimer: "Not authorized by any candidate

- 7 (2) A radio or television paid advertisement having reference

25 (3) The size and placement of an identification or disclaimer

- 22 SHALL ALSO CLEARLY STATE THE FOLLOWING DISCLAIMER: "NOT AUTHORIZED
- 23 BY ANY CANDIDATE COMMITTEE". IF THE COMMUNICATION DESCRIBED IN
- 24 SUBSECTION (1) RELATES TO A CANDIDATE AND IS NOT AN INDEPENDENT
- 25 EXPENDITURE, BUT IS PAID FOR BY A PERSON OTHER THAN THE CANDIDATE
- 26 TO WHOM IT IS RELATED, THE COMMUNICATION SHALL ALSO CLEARLY STATE
- 27 THE FOLLOWING DISCLAIMER:
