 - (b) "Employee" means an individual not less than —16—18 years of age employed by an employer on the premises of the employer or at a fixed site designated by the employer. —, and includes a minor employed under section 15(1) of the youth employment standards act,
 - (c) "Employer" means a person, firm, or corporation, including

- 1 the state and its political subdivisions, agencies, and
- 2 instrumentalities, and a person acting in the interest of the
- 3 employer, who employs 2 or more employees at any 1 time within a
- 4 calendar year. An employer shall be subject to this act during the
