## **HOUSE BILL No. 6281**

June 29, 2006, Introduced by Reps. Bieda, Condino and Gleason and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled

"Public health code,"

by amending section 17757 (MCL 333.17757), as amended by 1986 PA 304.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 17757. (1) Upon a request made in person or by telephone,
- 2 a pharmacist engaged in the business of selling drugs at retail
- 3 shall provide the current selling price of a drug dispensed by that
- 4 pharmacy or comparative current selling prices of generic and brand
- 5 name drugs dispensed by that pharmacy. The information shall be
- 6 provided to the person making the request before a drug is
- 7 dispensed to the person. A person who makes a request for price
- information under this subsection OR SUBSECTION (2) shall not be
- 9 obligated to purchase the drug for which the price or comparative

- 1 prices are requested.
- 2 (2) A PHARMACIST ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF SELLING DRUGS AT
- 3 RETAIL SHALL COMPILE A DRUG RETAIL PRICE LIST OF THE 150 MOST
- 4 FREQUENTLY PRESCRIBED DRUGS AS DETERMINED BY THE BOARD. THE BOARD
- 5 SHALL ANNUALLY REVIEW AND UPDATE THE DRUGS THAT ARE TO BE INCLUDED
- 6 ON THE DRUG RETAIL PRICE LIST AND MAKE THE CURRENT LIST AVAILABLE,
- 7 EITHER PRINTED OR ELECTRONICALLY, TO EACH PHARMACIST FREE OF
- 8 CHARGE. THE PHARMACIST SHALL INCLUDE ON THE DRUG RETAIL PRICE LIST
- 9 THE NAME OF THE DRUG, INCLUDING THE NAME OF ANY GENERIC DRUG IF
- 10 AVAILABLE FOR THAT DRUG, AND THE RETAIL PRICE FOR THOSE DRUGS. THE
- 11 PHARMACIST SHALL UPDATE THE PRICING ON THE DRUG RETAIL PRICE LIST
- 12 AT LEAST WEEKLY AND MAKE COPIES OF THE LIST AVAILABLE TO THE BOARD
- 13 AND TO THE PUBLIC UPON REQUEST. AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION, "RETAIL
- 14 PRICE" MEANS THE ACTUAL CURRENT SELLING PRICE TO BE PAID BY A SELF-
- 15 PAY OR UNINSURED PURCHASER.
- 16 (3)  $\frac{(2)}{}$  A pharmacist engaged in the business of selling
- 17 drugs at retail shall conspicuously display the notice described in
- 18 subsection -(3) (4) at each counter over which prescription drugs
- 19 are dispensed.
- 20 (4) -(3) The notice required under subsection -(2) (3) shall
- 21 be in substantially the following form:
- 22 NOTICE TO CONSUMERS
- 23 ABOUT PRESCRIPTION DRUGS
- 24 Under Michigan law, you have the right to find out the price
- 25 of a prescription drug before the pharmacist fills the
- 26 prescription. You are under no obligation to have the prescription
- 27 filled here and may use this price information to shop around at

- 1 other pharmacies. You may request price information in person or by
- 2 telephone.
- 3 Every pharmacy has the current selling prices of both generic
- 4 and brand name drugs dispensed by the pharmacy AND IS REQUIRED TO
- 5 COMPILE A DRUG RETAIL PRICE LIST OF THE 150 MOST COMMONLY
- 6 PRESCRIBED DRUGS.
- 7 Ask your pharmacist if a lower-cost generic drug is available
- 8 to fill your prescription. A generic drug contains the same
- 9 medicine as a brand name drug and is a suitable substitute in most
- 10 instances.
- 11 A generic drug may not be dispensed by your pharmacist if your
- 12 doctor has written "dispense as written" or the initials "d.a.w."
- 13 on the prescription.
- 14 If you have questions about the drugs which have been
- 15 prescribed for you, ask your doctor or pharmacist for more
- 16 information.
- 17 To avoid dangerous drug interactions, let your doctor and
- 18 pharmacist know about any other medications you are taking. This is
- 19 especially important if you have more than 1 doctor or have
- 20 prescriptions filled at more than 1 pharmacy.
- 21 (5) -(4) The notice required under subsection -(2) (3) shall
- 22 also contain the address and phone number of the board and the
- 23 department. The text of the notice shall be in at least 32-point
- 24 bold type and shall be printed on paper at least 11 inches by 17
- 25 inches in size. The notice may be printed on multiple pages.
- **26** (6) -(5) A copy of the notice required under subsection -(2)
- 27 (3) shall be provided to each licensee by the department.

- 1 Additional copies shall be available if needed from the department.
- 2 A person may duplicate or reproduce the notice if the duplication
- 3 or reproduction is a true copy of the notice as produced by the
- 4 department, without any additions or deletions whatsoever. THE
- 5 DEPARTMENT MAY CONTINUE TO DISTRIBUTE COPIES OF THE NOTICE REQUIRED
- 6 UNDER SUBSECTION (3) THAT ARE WITHIN ITS POSSESSION ON THE
- 7 EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SENTENCE UNTIL
- 8 THE DEPARTMENT'S STOCK IS EXHAUSTED OR UNTIL OCTOBER 1, 2006,
- 9 WHICHEVER IS SOONER. BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2006, THE DEPARTMENT
- 10 SHALL ONLY DISTRIBUTE THE COPIES OF THE NOTICE AS REVISED BY THE
- 11 AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SENTENCE.
- 12 (7) (6)— The pharmacist shall furnish to the purchaser of a
- 13 prescription drug at the time the drug is delivered to the
- 14 purchaser a receipt evidencing the transactions, which contains the
- 15 following:
- (a) The brand name of the drug, if applicable.
- 17 (b) The name of the manufacturer or the supplier of the drug,
- 18 if the drug does not have a brand name.
- 19 (c) The strength of the drug, if significant.
- (d) The quantity dispensed, if applicable.
- (e) The name and address of the pharmacy.
- (f) The serial number of the prescription.
- 23 (g) The date the prescription was originally dispensed.
- (h) The name of the prescriber.
- 25 (i) The name of patient for whom the drug was prescribed.
- 26 (j) The price for which the drug was sold to the purchaser.
- 27 (8) -(7) Subsection -(6)(a) (7)(A), (b), and (c) may be

- 1 omitted by a pharmacist only if the omission is expressly required
- 2 by the prescriber. The pharmacist shall retain a copy of each
- 3 receipt for 90 days. The inclusion of subsection  $\frac{-(6)}{-(7)}$  on the
- 4 prescription container label is a valid receipt to the purchaser.
- 5 Including subsection  $\frac{(6)}{(7)}$  (7) on the written prescription form and
- 6 retaining the form constitutes retention of a copy of the receipt.
- 7 (9)  $\overline{(8)}$  The board may promulgate rules to implement this
- 8 section. THE BOARD SHALL PROVIDE THE DEPARTMENT WITH COPIES OF THE
- 9 DRUG RETAIL PRICE LISTS RECEIVED, AND THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE
- 10 THOSE LISTS AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT'S
- 11 WEBSITE.
