A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code," by amending section 1147 (MCL 380.1147).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1147. (1) A <del>person, resident of</del> **CHILD WHO RESIDES IN** a
