- 3 OR THE SCHOOL DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT, A SCHOOL BUILDING PRINCIPAL,
- 4 OR ANOTHER SCHOOL OFFICIAL IF DESIGNATED BY THE BOARD OR BOARD OF
- 5 DIRECTORS, MAY AUTHORIZE OR ORDER THE SUSPENSION OR EXPULSION FROM
- 6 SCHOOL OF A PUPIL WHO IS CONVICTED OF POSSESSING OR SELLING A
- 7 CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE OR CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE ANALOGUE, WHETHER THE
- 8 ACTIVITY OCCURRED ON OR OFF SCHOOL PROPERTY, IF, IN THE JUDGMENT OF
 - THE BOARD OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS OR ITS DESIGNEE, THE INTEREST OF
