A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code," by amending section 1147 (MCL 380.1147).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1147. (1) A person, resident of CHILD WHO RESIDES IN a school district not maintaining a kindergarten and WHO IS at least 5 years of age on the first day of enrollment of the school year —, shall have a right to MAY attend school in the district.
 - (2) —In— EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION, IN a school district —where provision is made for— THAT PROVIDES kindergarten, —work,— a child —, resident of— WHO RESIDES IN the SCHOOL district —, is entitled to— MAY enroll in the kindergarten

if the child is at least 5 years of age on December 1 of the school

- 26 CHILD'S ELIGIBILITY TO ENROLL IN A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY.
