

SENATE BILL No. 845

October 26, 2005, Introduced by Senators SWITALSKI and GOSCHKA and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled
"The code of criminal procedure,"
by amending section 12f of chapter XVII (MCL 777.12f), as amended
by 2003 PA 134.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

CHAPTER XVII

Sec. 12f. This chapter applies to the following felonies
enumerated in sections 625 to 625o of chapter VI of the Michigan
vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, within chapter 257 of the Michigan
