

SENATE BILL No. 882

November 9, 2005, Introduced by Senators PATTERSON, JACOBS, GARCIA, JELINEK, KUIPERS, CROPSEY, BIRKHOLZ and TOY and referred to the Committee on Senior Citizens and Veterans Affairs.

A bill to designate the use of state land that is set aside to memorialize veterans; to prohibit certain acts; and to prescribe penalties.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as "the
2 veterans memorial property act".

3 Sec. 2. (1) The veterans memorial park and any other property
4 that is owned by this state and that is dedicated to memorializing
5 veterans shall be used solely for the purpose of honoring and
6 memorializing veterans of this state.

7 (2) The boundaries of property that is owned by the state and
8 that is dedicated to memorializing veterans shall not be
9 encroached.

10 (3) The property that is owned by the state and that is
11 dedicated to memorializing veterans shall not be desecrated.

1 Sec. 3. A person who violates this act is responsible for a
2 state civil infraction and may be ordered to pay a civil fine of
3 not more than \$500.00.
