## **SENATE BILL No. 1069**

February 23, 2006, Introduced by Senators SWITALSKI, BRATER, JACOBS, THOMAS, LELAND and SCHAUER and referred to the Committee on Agriculture, Forestry and Tourism.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," (MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding part 86.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 PART 86. CONCENTRATED ANIMAL FEEDING OPERATIONS
- 2 SEC. 8601. AS USED IN THIS PART:
  - (A) "AIR EMISSIONS PLAN" MEANS AN AIR EMISSIONS PLAN AS DESCRIBED UNDER SECTION 8631.
- 5 (B) "ANIMAL FEEDING OPERATION" OR "AFO" MEANS A LOT OR
- 6 FACILITY, OTHER THAN AN AQUACULTURE FACILITY REGISTERED UNDER THE
- 7 MICHIGAN AQUACULTURE DEVELOPMENT ACT, 1996 PA 199, MCL 286.871 TO
- 8 286.884, WHERE ANIMALS HAVE BEEN, ARE, OR WILL BE STABLED OR
- 9 CONFINED AND FED OR MAINTAINED FOR A TOTAL OF 45 DAYS OR MORE IN
- 10 ANY 12-MONTH PERIOD. AFO DOES NOT INCLUDE A LOT OR FACILITY IF

- 1 CROPS, VEGETATION, FORAGE GROWTH, OR POST-HARVEST RESIDUES ARE
- 2 SUSTAINED OVER ANY PORTION OF THE LOT OR FACILITY IN THE NORMAL
- 3 GROWING SEASON.
- 4 (C) "ANIMAL WASTE HANDLER" MEANS A COMMERCIAL ANIMAL WASTE
- 5 HANDLER OR A PRIMARY ANIMAL WASTE HANDLER.
- 6 (D) "COMMERCIAL ANIMAL WASTE HANDLER" MEANS A PERSON WHO, FOR
- 7 CONSIDERATION, HANDLES OR DISPOSES OF OR OFFERS TO HANDLE OR
- 8 DISPOSE OF MANURE, PRODUCTION AREA WASTE, OR PROCESS WASTEWATER
- 9 FROM AN ANIMAL FEEDING OPERATION OWNED OR OPERATED BY ANOTHER
- 10 PERSON.
- 11 (E) "COMPREHENSIVE NUTRIENT MANAGEMENT PLAN" OR "CNMP" MEANS A
- 12 COMPREHENSIVE NUTRIENT MANAGEMENT PLAN AS DESCRIBED UNDER SECTION
- 13 8621.
- 14 (F) "CONCENTRATED ANIMAL FEEDING OPERATION" OR "CAFO" MEANS A
- 15 LARGE CAFO, MEDIUM CAFO, OR SMALL CAFO. FOR THE PURPOSES OF
- 16 DETERMINING THE NUMBER OF ANIMALS AT AN OPERATION, 2 OR MORE AFOS
- 17 UNDER COMMON OWNERSHIP ARE CONSIDERED TO BE A SINGLE AFO IF THEY
- 18 ADJOIN EACH OTHER OR IF THEY USE A COMMON AREA OR SYSTEM FOR THE
- 19 DISPOSAL OF WASTES.
- 20 (G) "CNMP PROVIDER" MEANS A PERSON CERTIFIED BY THE UNITED
- 21 STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, NATURAL RESOURCES CONSERVATION
- 22 SERVICE, TO PREPARE CNMPS.
- 23 (H) "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 24 ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY OR HIS OR HER DESIGNEE TO WHOM THE DIRECTOR
- 25 DELEGATES A POWER OR DUTY BY WRITTEN INSTRUMENT.
- 26 (I) "DISCHARGE" MEANS ANY DIRECT OR INDIRECT DISCHARGE OF ANY
- 27 WASTE, WASTE EFFLUENT, WASTEWATER, POLLUTANT, OR ANY COMBINATION

- 1 THEREOF INTO ANY OF THE WATERS OF THE STATE OR, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE
- 2 PROVIDED IN THIS SUBDIVISION, UPON THE GROUND. DISCHARGE DOES NOT
- 3 INCLUDE LAND APPLICATION, BUT DOES INCLUDE RUNOFF INTO SURFACE
- 4 WATERS FROM LAND APPLICATION.
- 5 SEC. 8603. AS USED IN THIS PART:
- 6 (A) "FEDERAL ACT" MEANS THE CLEAN WATER ACT, 33 USC 1251 TO
- 7 1387, AND THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED THEREUNDER.
- 8 (B) "GENERAL PERMIT" MEANS A NATIONAL PERMIT ISSUED
- 9 AUTHORIZING A CATEGORY OF SIMILAR DISCHARGES.
- 10 (C) "LAND APPLICATION AREA" MEANS LAND UNDER THE CONTROL OF AN
- 11 AFO OWNER OR OPERATOR, WHETHER IT IS OWNED, RENTED, LEASED, OR
- 12 SUBJECT TO AN ACCESS AGREEMENT, TO WHICH PRODUCTION AREA WASTE OR
- 13 PROCESS WASTEWATER IS OR MAY BE APPLIED. LAND APPLICATION AREA
- 14 INCLUDES LAND NOT OWNED BY THE AFO OWNER OR OPERATOR BUT ON WHICH
- 15 THE AFO OWNER OR OPERATOR HAS CONTROL OF THE LAND APPLICATION OF
- 16 PRODUCTION AREA WASTE OR CAFO PROCESS WASTEWATER.
- 17 (D) "LARGE CAFO" IS AN AFO THAT STABLES OR CONFINES 1 OR MORE
- 18 OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 19 (i) 700 OR MORE MATURE DAIRY COWS, WHETHER MILKED OR DRY.
- (ii) 1,000 OR MORE VEAL CALVES.
- 21 (iii) 1,000 OR MORE CATTLE OTHER THAN MATURE DAIRY COWS OR VEAL
- 22 CALVES. AS USED IN THIS SUBPARAGRAPH, "CATTLE" INCLUDES HEIFERS,
- 23 STEERS, BULLS, AND COW/CALF PAIRS.
- (iv) 2,500 OR MORE SWINE EACH WEIGHING 55 POUNDS OR MORE.
- 25 (v) 10,000 OR MORE SWINE EACH WEIGHING LESS THAN 55 POUNDS.
- (vi) 500 OR MORE HORSES.
- (vii) 10,000 OR MORE SHEEP OR LAMBS.

- 1 (viii) 55,000 OR MORE TURKEYS.
- 2 (ix) 30,000 OR MORE LAYING HENS OR BROILERS, IF THE AFO USES A
- 3 LIQUID MANURE HANDLING SYSTEM.
- 4 (x) 125,000 OR MORE CHICKENS (OTHER THAN LAYING HENS), IF THE
- 5 AFO USES OTHER THAN A LIOUID MANURE HANDLING SYSTEM.
- 6 (xi) 82,000 OR MORE LAYING HENS, IF THE AFO USES OTHER THAN A
- 7 LIQUID MANURE HANDLING SYSTEM.
- 8 (xii) 30,000 OR MORE DUCKS, IF THE AFO USES OTHER THAN A LIQUID
- 9 MANURE HANDLING SYSTEM.
- 10 (xiii) 5,000 OR MORE DUCKS, IF THE AFO USES A LIQUID MANURE
- 11 HANDLING SYSTEM.
- 12 (xiv) ANY ANIMALS OF A TYPE NOT LISTED IN THIS SUBDIVISION, OR
- 13 ANY COMBINATION OF TYPES OF ANIMALS, IN SUCH NUMBERS AS WILL
- 14 PRODUCE AN AMOUNT OF WASTE EQUIVALENT TO THAT PRODUCED BY ANIMALS
- 15 DESCRIBED IN ANY OTHER SUBPARAGRAPH OF THIS SUBDIVISION.
- 16 (E) "MANURE" INCLUDES MANURE, BEDDING, COMPOST, AND RAW
- 17 MATERIALS OR OTHER MATERIALS COMMINGLED WITH MANURE OR SET ASIDE
- 18 FOR DISPOSAL.
- 19 (F) "MEDIUM CAFO" MEANS AN AFO THAT MEETS BOTH OF THE
- 20 FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:
- 21 (i) ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS ARE MET:
- 22 (A) THE AFO HAS BEEN DESIGNATED BY THE DEPARTMENT AS A CAFO
- 23 UNDER SECTION 8613.
- 24 (B) POLLUTANTS ARE DISCHARGED FROM THE AFO'S PRODUCTION AREA
- 25 INTO WATERS OF THE STATE THROUGH A MANMADE DITCH, PIPE, TILE,
- 26 SWALE, FLUSHING SYSTEM, OR OTHER SIMILAR MANMADE CONVEYANCE.
- 27 (C) POLLUTANTS ARE DISCHARGED FROM THE PRODUCTION AREA

- 1 DIRECTLY INTO WATERS OF THE STATE WHICH ORIGINATE OUTSIDE OF THE
- 2 FACILITY AND PASS OVER, ACROSS, OR THROUGH THE FACILITY OR
- 3 OTHERWISE COME INTO DIRECT CONTACT WITH THE ANIMALS CONFINED IN THE
- 4 OPERATION.
- 5 (D) POLLUTANTS ARE DISCHARGED FROM THE AFO'S LAND APPLICATION
- 6 AREA INTO WATERS OF THE STATE.
- 7 (ii) THE AFO STABLES OR CONFINES 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 8 (A) 200 TO 699 MATURE DAIRY COWS, WHETHER MILKED OR DRY.
- 9 (B) 300 TO 999 VEAL CALVES.
- 10 (C) 300 TO 999 CATTLE OTHER THAN MATURE DAIRY COWS OR VEAL
- 11 CALVES. AS USED IN THIS SUB-SUBPARAGRAPH, "CATTLE" INCLUDES
- 12 HEIFERS, STEERS, BULLS, AND COW/CALF PAIRS.
- 13 (D) 750 TO 2,499 SWINE EACH WEIGHING 55 POUNDS OR MORE.
- 14 (E) 3,000 TO 9,999 SWINE EACH WEIGHING LESS THAN 55 POUNDS.
- 15 (F) 150 TO 499 HORSES.
- 16 (G) 3,000 TO 9,999 SHEEP OR LAMBS.
- 17 (H) 16,500 TO 54,999 TURKEYS.
- 18 (I) 9,000 TO 29,999 LAYING HENS OR BROILERS, IF THE AFO USES A
- 19 LIQUID MANURE HANDLING SYSTEM.
- 20 (J) 37,500 TO 124,999 CHICKENS (OTHER THAN LAYING HENS), IF
- 21 THE AFO USES OTHER THAN A LIQUID MANURE HANDLING SYSTEM.
- 22 (K) 25,000 TO 81,999 LAYING HENS, IF THE AFO USES OTHER THAN A
- 23 LIQUID MANURE HANDLING SYSTEM.
- 24 (L) 10,000 TO 29,999 DUCKS, IF THE AFO USES OTHER THAN A
- 25 LIQUID MANURE HANDLING SYSTEM.
- 26 (M) 1,500 TO 4,999 DUCKS, IF THE AFO USES A LIQUID MANURE
- 27 HANDLING SYSTEM.

- 1 (N) ANY ANIMALS OF A TYPE NOT LISTED IN THIS SUBPARAGRAPH, OR
- 2 ANY COMBINATION OF TYPES OF ANIMALS, IN SUCH NUMBERS AS WILL
- 3 PRODUCE AN AMOUNT OF WASTE EQUIVALENT TO THAT PRODUCED BY ANIMALS
- 4 DESCRIBED IN ANY OTHER SUB-SUBPARAGRAPH OF THIS SUBPARAGRAPH.
- 5 SEC. 8605. AS USED IN THIS PART:
- 6 (A) "NO-POTENTIAL-TO-DISCHARGE DETERMINATION" MEANS A
- 7 DETERMINATION BY THE DEPARTMENT THAT THERE IS NO POTENTIAL FOR ANY
- 8 PRODUCTION AREA WASTE OR PROCESS WASTEWATER FROM A PARTICULAR CAFO
- 9 TO BE ADDED TO WATERS OF THE STATE UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCE OR
- 10 CLIMATIC CONDITION.
- 11 (B) "NPDES" MEANS THE NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION
- 12 SYSTEM ESTABLISHED BY THE FEDERAL ACT.
- 13 (C) "PERSON" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL, PARTNERSHIP, ASSOCIATION,
- 14 CORPORATION, INDUSTRY, OR PUBLIC BODY.
- 15 (D) "POLLUTANT" INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, MANURE AND
- 16 PRODUCTION AREA WASTE.
- 17 (E) "PRIMARY ANIMAL WASTE HANDLER" MEANS THE INDIVIDUAL OWNING
- 18 AND OPERATING A SPECIFIC CAFO OR EMPLOYED BY A SPECIFIC CAFO WHO IS
- 19 DESIGNATED AS BEING PRIMARILY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE HANDLING OF
- 20 MANURE, PRODUCTION AREA WASTE, OR PROCESS WASTEWATER.
- 21 (F) "PROCESS WASTEWATER" MEANS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 22 (i) SPILLAGE OR OVERFLOW OF WATER USED FOR CAFO ANIMAL OR
- 23 POULTRY WATERING SYSTEMS.
- 24 (ii) WATER DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY USED AT A CAFO FOR WASHING,
- 25 CLEANING, OR FLUSHING PENS, BARNS, MANURE PITS, OR OTHER
- 26 FACILITIES; FOR DIRECT CONTACT SWIMMING, WASHING, OR SPRAY COOLING
- 27 OF ANIMALS; OR FOR DUST CONTROL.

- 1 (iv) ANY WATER THAT COMES INTO CONTACT WITH, OR IS A
- 2 CONSTITUENT OF, ANY CAFO RAW MATERIALS, PRODUCTS, OR BYPRODUCTS,
- 3 INCLUDING MANURE, LITTER, FEED, MILK, EGGS, OR BEDDING.
- 4 (G) "PRODUCTION AREA" MEANS THAT PART OF AN AFO THAT INCLUDES
- 5 ANIMAL CONFINEMENT AREA, MANURE STORAGE AREA, RAW MATERIALS STORAGE
- 6 AREA, WASTE CONTAINMENT AREAS, ANY EGG WASHING OR EGG PROCESSING
- 7 FACILITY, AND ANY AREA USED IN THE STORAGE, HANDLING, TREATMENT, OR
- 8 DISPOSAL OF MORTALITIES. AS USED IN THIS SUBDIVISION:
- 9 (i) "ANIMAL CONFINEMENT AREA" INCLUDES OPEN LOTS, HOUSED LOTS,
- 10 FEEDLOTS, CONFINEMENT HOUSES, STALL BARNS, FREE STALL BARNS, MILK
- 11 ROOMS, MILKING CENTERS, COWYARDS, BARNYARDS, MEDICATION PENS,
- 12 WALKERS, ANIMAL WALKWAYS, AND STABLES.
- 13 (ii) "MANURE STORAGE AREA" INCLUDES LAGOONS, RUNOFF PONDS,
- 14 STORAGE SHEDS, STOCKPILES, UNDERHOUSE OR PIT STORAGES, LIQUID
- 15 IMPOUNDMENTS, STATIC PILES, AND COMPOSTING PILES.
- 16 (iii) "RAW MATERIALS STORAGE AREA" INCLUDES FEED SILOS, SILAGE
- 17 BUNKERS, AND BEDDING MATERIALS.
- 18 (iv) "WASTE CONTAINMENT AREA" INCLUDES SETTLING BASINS AND
- 19 AREAS WITHIN BERMS AND DIVERSIONS THAT SEPARATE UNCONTAMINATED
- 20 STORM WATER.
- 21 (H) "PRODUCTION AREA WASTE" MEANS MANURE OR ANY WASTE FROM THE
- 22 PRODUCTION AREA AND ANY PRECIPITATION, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED
- 23 TO, RAIN OR SNOW, THAT COMES INTO CONTACT WITH, OR IS CONTAMINATED
- 24 BY, MANURE OR ANY OF THE COMPONENTS LISTED IN THE DEFINITION OF
- 25 PRODUCTION AREA. PRODUCTION AREA WASTE DOES NOT INCLUDE WATER FROM
- 26 LAND APPLICATION AREAS.
- 27 (I) "SMALL CAFO" MEANS AN AFO THAT IS DESIGNATED A CAFO BY THE

- 1 DEPARTMENT UNDER SECTION 8613 AND IS NOT A MEDIUM CAFO.
- 2 (J) "STORM WATER" MEANS STORM WATER RUNOFF, SNOWMELT RUNOFF,
- 3 AND SURFACE RUNOFF AND DRAINAGE.
- 4 (K) "WASTEWATER" MEANS LIQUID WASTE DISCHARGES DISCHARGED
- 5 DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY INTO THE WATERS OF THE STATE THAT RESULT
- 6 FROM INDUSTRIAL AND COMMERCIAL PROCESSES AND MUNICIPAL OPERATIONS,
- 7 INCLUDING LIQUID OR WATER-CARRIED PROCESS WASTE, COOLING AND
- 8 CONDENSING WATERS, AND SANITARY SEWAGE.
- 9 (1) "WATERS OF THE STATE" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION
- 10 3101.
- 11 SEC. 8607. 40 CFR 412 IS ADOPTED BY REFERENCE EXCEPT THAT THE
- 12 DEFINITION FOR "LAND APPLICATION AREA" SHALL BE AS DEFINED IN
- 13 SECTION 8603 AND EXCEPT TO THE EXTENT OF ANY OTHER CONFLICT WITH
- 14 THIS PART.
