THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 425. (1) UPON RECEIPT OF A WRITTEN REQUEST FROM AN
- 2 INDIVIDUAL WHO IS AN OUTSOURCED WORKER OR IS UNEMPLOYED AS A RESULT
- 3 OF THE BANKRUPTCY OF HIS OR HER EMPLOYER, A DOMESTIC CREDIT UNION
- 4 SHALL ALLOW THE INDIVIDUAL TO DEFER MAKING PAYMENTS OF PRINCIPAL
- 5 AND TO MAKE PAYMENTS OF INTEREST ONLY ON ANY ELIGIBLE LOAN MADE OR
- 6 SERVICED BY THE DOMESTIC CREDIT UNION, WITHOUT ASSESSMENT OF A
- PENALTY OR THE ACCRUAL OF ADDITIONAL INTEREST AND WITHOUT DECLARING
- B A DEFAULT ON THE LOAN, UNTIL THE FIRST OF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING
