- 1 SEC. 22B. (1) UPON RECEIPT OF A WRITTEN REQUEST FROM AN
- 2 INDIVIDUAL WHO IS AN OUTSOURCED WORKER OR IS UNEMPLOYED AS A RESULT
- 3 OF THE BANKRUPTCY OF HIS OR HER EMPLOYER, A LICENSEE OR REGISTRANT
- 4 SHALL ALLOW THE INDIVIDUAL TO DEFER MAKING PAYMENTS OF PRINCIPAL
- 5 AND TO MAKE PAYMENTS OF INTEREST ONLY ON ANY MORTGAGE LOAN MADE OR
- SERVICED BY THE LICENSEE OR REGISTRANT, WITHOUT ASSESSMENT OF A
- 7 PENALTY OR THE ACCRUAL OF ADDITIONAL INTEREST AND WITHOUT DECLARING
- A DEFAULT ON THE LOAN, UNTIL THE FIRST OF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING
