

SENATE BILL No. 1323

June 20, 2006, Introduced by Senators GEORGE and GOSCHKA and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled
"Revised judicature act of 1961,"
(MCL 600.101 to 600.9947) by adding section 1350b; and to repeal
acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 **SEC. 1350B. THE RIGHT TO PEREMPTORILY CHALLENGE JURORS IN A**
2 **CIVIL OR CRIMINAL CASE IS ABOLISHED.**

3 Enacting section 1. Sections 12 and 13 of chapter VIII and
4 section 17 of chapter XIV of the code of criminal procedure, 1927
5 PA 175, MCL 768.12, 768.13, and 774.17, are repealed.
