 - (2) The state treasurer shall credit to the WARM Michigan fund amounts contributed pursuant to section 436 of the income tax act of 1967, 1967 PA 281, MCL 206.436.
 - (3) The state treasurer shall direct the investment of the WARM Michigan fund money in the same manner as other funds are
