<u>Overview</u>

The Department of Natural Resources (DNR) manages, conserves, and protects Michigan's resources. Programs include forest management, land and minerals management, wildlife and fisheries management, conservation law enforcement, and state parks and forest campgrounds.

Major Budget Changes

- House adds \$2,000,000 to timber management programs
- House retains funding for Payment in Lieu of Taxes and recommends funding
- House adds \$1,000,000 funding for grants to Conservation Districts (Department of Agriculture).
- House adds \$500,000 for fish hatchery operations and public outreach and education programs.

Major Boilerplate Changes From FY 2007-08

Sec. 218. Rule Promulgation - DELETED

Requires report on policy changes made to implement a public act; DNR prohibited from adopting a rule that will apply to a small business if it has a disproportionate economic impact.

Sec. 223. Workgroup on Long Term Funding - ADDED BY THE HOUSE

Intent of the Legislature that recommendations of the long term funding work group be included in line item appropriations.

Sec. 405. Payments in Lieu of Taxes: Payments Deadline- ADDED BY THE HOUSE

Requires payment to local governmental units by February 14, if billings are submitted by December 1, 2008, and are accurate and complete.

Sec. 706. Plan to Generate Corporate Park Sponsorship Revenue - DELETED

Directs Natural Resource Commission to develop a plan to encourage corporate sponsorship of state parks.

Sec. 802. Conservation Districts - ADDED BY THE HOUSE

Provides \$1,000,000 for grants to Soil Conservation Districts through an interdepartmental transfer to the Department of Agriculture.
