## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5741

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled
"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"
by amending section 40114 (MCL 324.40114), as amended by 2004 PA
587, and by adding section 40115.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 40114. (1) The department may issue a permit to a person
- 2 who is unable to walk because the person is a paraplegic or an
- 3 amputee or because of a disease or injury that has rendered the
- 4 person permanently disabled. A permit issued under this subsection
- 5 authorizes the person to take game during the open season for that
- 6 game, including deer of either sex, from or upon a standing vehicle
- 7 if that person holds a license to take that game issued pursuant to
- 8 part 435 and complies with all other laws and rules for the taking
- 9 of game.
- 10 (2) The department may issue a permit to a person who is

- 1 permanently disabled and who has full use of only 1 arm and who
- 2 upon investigation is unable to hold, aim, and shoot a bow. A
- 3 permit issued under this subsection authorizes the person to take
- 4 game during the open season for that game with a bow that has been
- 5 modified so that the bow may be held, aimed, and shot with 1 arm OR
- 6 FOOT, if that person holds a license to take that game issued
- 7 pursuant to part 435 and complies with all other laws and rules for
- 8 the taking of game.
- 9 (3) In addition, the department may issue permits authorizing
- 10 1 or more of the following:
- 11 (a) The taking or possession of animals for the purpose of
- 12 rehabilitating animals.
- 13 (b) The taking of animals to prevent or control damage and
- 14 nuisance caused by the animals.
- 15 (c) The collection, transportation, possession, or disposition
- 16 of animals and parts of animals for scientific purposes.
- 17 (d) The public exhibition of animals.
- 18 (e) Taxidermy.
- 19 (f) The disposition of accidentally or unlawfully taken or
- 20 injured animals or animals that are unlawfully possessed.
- 21 (g) The taking of game with a crossbow by a person who is
- 22 permanently disabled.
- 23 (4) A permit issued under this section may be suspended,
- 24 revoked, annulled, withdrawn, recalled, canceled, or amended
- 25 pursuant to the administrative procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306,
- 26 MCL 24.201 to 24.328. If the holder of a permit is convicted of
- 27 violating this section, his or her permit or license may be revoked

- 1 and any animal and the parts of any animal in his or her possession
- 2 shall be disposed of in a manner approved by the department.
- 3 (5) Fees received for permits and licenses issued under this
- 4 section shall be forwarded by the department to the state treasurer
- 5 to be credited to the game and fish protection account of the
- 6 Michigan conservation and recreation legacy fund provided for in
- 7 section 2010.
- 8 SEC. 40115. A PERSON MAY TAKE GAME WITH A CROSSBOW DURING THE
- 9 OPEN SEASON FOR THAT GAME IF THAT PERSON HOLDS A LICENSE TO TAKE
- 10 THAT GAME ISSUED UNDER PART 435 AND COMPLIES WITH ALL OTHER LAWS
- 11 AND RULES FOR THE TAKING OF THAT GAME.
