SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5759

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 16401 (MCL 333.16401), as amended by 2002 PA 734.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 16401. (1) As used in this part:
- 2 (a) "Chiropractor", "chiropractic physician", "doctor of
- 3 chiropractic", or "d.c." means an individual licensed under this
- 4 article to engage in the practice of chiropractic.
- 5 (B) "MUSCULOSKELETAL SYSTEM" MEANS THE SYSTEM OF MUSCLES,
- 6 TENDONS, LIGAMENTS, BONES, JOINTS, AND ASSOCIATED TISSUES THAT
- 7 MOVES THE BODY AND MAINTAINS ITS FORM.
- 8 (C) (b) "Practice of chiropractic" means that discipline
- 9 within the healing arts which THAT deals with the human nervous

- 1 system and its relationship to the spinal column and its THE
- 2 MUSCULOSKELETAL SYSTEM AND THEIR interrelationship with other body
- 3 systems. Practice of chiropractic includes the following:
- 4 (i) Diagnosis, including spinal analysis, to determine the
- 5 existence of spinal subluxations or misalignments that produce
- 6 nerve interference, indicating the necessity for chiropractic care.
- 7 THE DIAGNOSIS OF HUMAN CONDITIONS AND NEUROMUSCULAR AND SKELETAL
- 8 DISORDERS RELATED TO SUBLUXATIONS, MISALIGNMENTS, AND JOINT
- 9 DYSFUNCTIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETECTING AND CORRECTING THOSE
- 10 DISORDERS OR OFFERING ADVICE TO SEEK TREATMENT FROM OTHER HEALTH
- 11 PROFESSIONALS IN ORDER TO RESTORE AND MAINTAIN HEALTH.
- 12 (ii) THE EVALUATION OF CONDITIONS OR SYMPTOMS RELATED TO
- 13 MISALIGNMENTS, SUBLUXATIONS, AND JOINT DYSFUNCTION THROUGH PHYSICAL
- 14 EXAMINATION, THE TAKING AND REVIEWING OF PATIENT HEALTH
- 15 INFORMATION, THE PERFORMANCE OR ORDERING OF TESTS, AND THE USE OF
- 16 X-RAY OR OTHER IMAGING TECHNOLOGY. THE PERFORMANCE OR ORDERING OF
- 17 TESTS AND THE USE OF X-RAY OR OTHER IMAGING TECHNOLOGY IN THE
- 18 PRACTICE OF CHIROPRACTIC IS REGULATED BY RULES PROMULGATED UNDER
- 19 SECTION 16423.
- 20 (iii) (iii) A THE chiropractic adjustment of spinal subluxations,
- 21 or misalignments, and JOINT DYSFUNCTION AND THE TREATMENT OF
- 22 related bones and tissues for the establishment of neural integrity
- 23 utilizing the inherent recuperative powers of the body for
- 24 restoration and maintenance of health AND STRUCTURAL STABILITY.
- 25 (iv) (iii) The use of PHYSICAL MEASURES, analytical instruments,
- 26 nutritional advice, rehabilitative exercise, and adjustment
- 27 apparatus regulated by rules promulgated by the board pursuant to

- 4 (2) The practice of chiropractic does not include the ANY OF
- 5 THE FOLLOWING:
- 6 (i) THE performance of incisive surgical procedures, the
- 7 performance of an invasive procedure requiring instrumentation, or
- 8 the ANY PROCEDURE THAT CUTS OR PUNCTURES THE SKIN.
- 9 (ii) THE dispensing or prescribing of drugs or medicine.
- 10 (iii) EXCEPT FOR DIAGNOSTIC PURPOSES ONLY, THE USE OF X-RAY. [(iv) THE PERFORMANCE OF AN INVASIVE PROCEDURE INVOLVING A BODY ORIFICE OR CAVITY THAT IS NOT PART OF OR RELATED TO A PROCEDURE OR TEST ALLOWED BY RULES PROMULGATED UNDER SECTION 16423.]
- 11 (3) (2)—In addition to the definitions in this part, article 1
- 12 contains general definitions and principles of construction
- 13 applicable to all articles in this code and part 161 contains
- 14 definitions applicable to this part.
