## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 6102

A bill to amend 2004 PA 452, entitled "Identity theft protection act,"

(MCL 445.61 to 445.77) by adding section 12c.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 12C. (1) WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE
- 2 AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SECTION, EACH QUALIFIED PERSON SHALL
- 3 ESTABLISH A WRITTEN IDENTITY THEFT PREVENTION PROGRAM THAT MEETS
- 4 ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 5 (A) INCLUDES REASONABLE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR DETECTING,
- 6 PREVENTING, AND MITIGATING IDENTITY THEFT.
- 7 (B) IDENTIFIES SPECIFIC ACTIVITIES THAT INDICATE THE POSSIBLE
- 8 EXISTENCE OF IDENTITY THEFT AND ADDRESSES THOSE ACTIVITIES IN THE
- 9 PROGRAM.

- 20 ACCOUNTS TO RESIDENTS OF THIS STATE.
