SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 734

A bill to amend 1984 PA 431, entitled "The management and budget act," by amending section 141 (MCL 18.1141).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 141. The department shall do all of the following:
- 2 (a) Survey and examine the administrative organization and
- 3 operations of state agencies to secure greater administrative and
- 4 program efficiency and economy, to minimize the duplication of
- 5 activities among state agencies and between state agencies and
- 6 businesses, and to effect a better organization and consolidation
- 7 of functions among state agencies. The findings of the surveys
- 8 shall be incorporated and separately identified in the executive
- 9 budget that is transmitted to the legislature. Through the

- 1 executive budget process, the director may require state agencies
- 2 to assist the department in making its surveys.
- 3 (b) Provide for expert and uniform conduct in state operations
- 4 applicable to all state agencies.
- 5 (c) Provide centralized management of auxiliary services when
- 6 advantageous to state government, after consultation with any
- 7 affected state agency.
- 8 (d) Establish a comprehensive system of internal controls in
- 9 the management of the state's financial affairs and record the
- 10 transactions both in accordance with generally accepted accounting
- 11 principles and as required by law.
- 12 (e) Plan, prepare, and execute a comprehensive state budget
- 13 pursuant to the state constitution of 1963.
- 14 (F) OBTAIN FROM THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MICHIGAN
- 15 STRATEGIC FUND AND MAKE AVAILABLE TO STATE AND FEDERAL AGENCIES AND
- 16 THE PUBLIC A CURRENT LIST OF BUSINESS ENTERPRISES DESIGNATED AS
- 17 MICHIGAN PATRIOT BUSINESSES UNDER THE MICHIGAN PATRIOT BUSINESS
- 18 ACT.
- 19 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 20 unless all of the following bills of the 94th Legislature are
- 21 enacted into law:
