

# SENATE BILL No. 1075

January 31, 2008, Introduced by Senator SANBORN and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled  
"The code of criminal procedure,"  
by amending sections 11b and 12d of chapter XVII (MCL 777.11b and  
777.12d), section 11b as amended by 2005 PA 207 and section 12d  
as amended by 2002 PA 127.

### CHAPTER XVII
