

HOUSE BILL No. 4158

January 30, 2007, Introduced by Reps. Wojno, Meadows, Kathleen Law, Gonzales, Clack, Polidori and Hood and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled
"Public health code,"
(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 21525.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 21525. (1) BEFORE FEBRUARY 1 OF EACH YEAR, EACH HOSPITAL
2 SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE DEPARTMENT SUMMARIZING THE NUMBER OF
3 HOSPITAL-ACQUIRED INFECTIONS CONTRACTED BY PATIENTS IN THE
4 IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING CALENDAR YEAR. THE ANNUAL REPORT OF HOSPITAL-
5 ACQUIRED INFECTIONS SHALL BE SUBMITTED ON A FORM AND IN A MANNER AS
6 PRESCRIBED BY THE DEPARTMENT. THE DEPARTMENT MAY REQUIRE ANY
7 INFORMATION CONSIDERED NECESSARY FOR THE SURVEILLANCE, CONTROL, AND
8 PREVENTION OF HOSPITAL-ACQUIRED INFECTIONS.

9 (2) THE REPORTING FORM SHALL BREAK DOWN THE NUMBER OF
10 HOSPITAL-ACQUIRED INFECTIONS CONTRACTED BY PATIENTS WITHIN EACH

1 UNIT OR DEPARTMENT WITHIN THE HOSPITAL. THE REPORTING FORM SHALL
2 NOT CONTAIN THE NAME OF THE PATIENTS, COMMON IDENTIFIERS SUCH AS
3 SOCIAL SECURITY OR DRIVER LICENSE NUMBERS, OR OTHER INFORMATION
4 IDENTIFIERS THAT WOULD MAKE IT POSSIBLE TO IDENTIFY IN ANY MANNER
5 OR IN ANY CIRCUMSTANCES THE PATIENT.

6 (3) THE DEPARTMENT MAY PROMULGATE RULES TO PROVIDE FOR THE
7 STANDARDS AND PROCEDURES FOR THE COLLECTION, ANALYSIS, AND
8 REPORTING UNDER THIS SECTION OF HOSPITAL-ACQUIRED INFECTIONS AND
9 FOR THE PRESERVATION OF THE ANONYMITY OF EACH PATIENT WHILE
10 REPORTING THE NUMBER OF HOSPITAL-ACQUIRED INFECTIONS TO THE
11 DEPARTMENT.

12 (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "HOSPITAL-ACQUIRED INFECTION"
13 MEANS A NOSOCOMIAL INFECTION THAT IS A LOCALIZED OR SYSTEMIC
14 CONDITION RESULTING FROM AN ADVERSE REACTION TO THE PRESENCE OF AN
15 INFECTIOUS AGENT OR ITS TOXIN AND THAT WAS NOT PRESENT OR
16 INCUBATING AT THE TIME A PATIENT WAS ADMITTED TO THE HOSPITAL FOR
17 MEDICAL TREATMENT.
