February 20, 2007, Introduced by Reps. LeBlanc, Miller, Hammel, Hammon, Corriveau, Clemente, Dean and Bauer and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code," by amending section 636 (MCL 257.636).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 636. (1) The following rules shall govern the overtaking and passing of vehicles proceeding in the same direction, subject to those limitations, exceptions, and special rules stated in sections 637 to 643a:
 - (a) The driver OPERATOR of a vehicle overtaking another vehicle proceeding in the same direction shall pass at a safe distance to the left of that vehicle, and when safely clear of the overtaken vehicle shall take up a position as near the right-hand edge of the main traveled portion of the highway as is practicable.
 - (B) THE OPERATOR OF A VEHICLE SHALL NOT OVERTAKE AND PASS
