## **HOUSE BILL No. 4579**

April 5, 2007, Introduced by Rep. Hansen and referred to the Committee on Agriculture.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled

"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"

by amending section 36204 (MCL 324.36204), as added by 2000 PA 262.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 36204. (1) The agricultural preservation fund board is
  created within the department.
  - (2) The board shall consist of the following members:
- 4 (a) The director of the department or his or her designee.
- (b) The director of the department of natural resources or hisor her designee.
  - (c) Five SEVEN individuals appointed by the governor as follows:
    - (i) Two individuals representing agricultural interests.

- 1 (ii) One individual representing conservation interests.
- 2 (iii) One individual representing development interests.
- 3 (iv) TWO INDIVIDUALS REPRESENTING COUNTY OR TOWNSHIP PURCHASE
- 4 OF DEVELOPMENT RIGHTS PROGRAMS.
- 5 (v)  $\frac{(iv)}{(iv)}$  One individual representing the general public.
- 6 (d) In addition to the members described in subdivisions (a)
- 7 to (c), the director of the department may appoint 2 individuals
- 8 with knowledge and expertise in agriculture or land use, or local
- 9 government, as nonvoting members.
- 10 (3) The members first appointed to the board shall be
- 11 appointed within 60 days after the effective date of this section
- 12 JUNE 29, 2000.
- 13 (4) Members of the board appointed under subsection (2)(c) and
- 14 (d) shall serve for terms of 4 years or until a successor is
- 15 appointed, whichever is later. However, of the members first
- 16 appointed under subsection (2)(c), 1 shall be appointed for a term
- 17 of 2 years, 2 shall be appointed for terms of 3 years, and 2 shall
- 18 be appointed for terms of 4 years. THE 2 MEMBERS INITIALLY
- 19 APPOINTED UNDER SUBSECTION (2) (C) (iv) REPRESENTING COUNTY OR
- 20 TOWNSHIP PURCHASE OF DEVELOPMENT RIGHTS PROGRAMS SHALL BE APPOINTED
- 21 FOR 2-YEAR TERMS.
- 22 (5) A majority of the members of the board constitute a quorum
- 23 for the transaction of business at a meeting of the board. A
- 24 majority of the members present and serving are required for
- 25 official action of the board.
- 26 (6) Members of the board shall serve without compensation.
- 27 However, members of the board may be reimbursed for their actual

- 1 and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their
- 2 official duties as members of the board.
- 3 (7) The board shall annually elect a chairperson and a vice-
- 4 chairperson from among its members.
- 5 (8) The board may remove a member of the board for
- 6 incompetency, dereliction of duty, malfeasance, misfeasance, or
- 7 nonfeasance in office, or any other good cause.
- 8 (9) A vacancy on the board shall be filled for the unexpired
- 9 term in the same manner as the original appointment.
