A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act,"

(MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding section 30111a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 30111A. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT DO ANY OF THE FOLLOWING AT
- 2 A PUBLIC ROAD UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF A LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT,
- 3 WHICH ROAD TERMINATES AT AND PROVIDES PUBLIC ACCESS TO AN INLAND
- 4 LAKE OR STREAM, UNLESS A RECORDED DEED, RECORDED EASEMENT, OR OTHER
- 5 RECORDED DEDICATION OR EVIDENCE REGARDING THE SCOPE OF THE
- 6 DEDICATION PROVIDES OTHERWISE:
- 7 (A) CONSTRUCT, INSTALL, OR MAINTAIN A BOAT HOIST ON THE ROAD
- OR IN THE ADJACENT WATERS.
 - (B) CONSTRUCT, INSTALL, OR MAINTAIN A SEASONAL DOCK LARGER

- 1 THAN 4 FEET WIDE OR 25 FEET LONG UNLESS THE PURPOSE OF THE SEASONAL
- 2 DOCK IS TO AID IN THE PUBLIC ACCESS AND THE CONSTRUCTION,

- 13 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1) IS RESPONSIBLE FOR A

- 16 (3) THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF A LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT MAY
- 17 ADOPT AN ORDINANCE SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR TO THIS SECTION. A
- 18 VIOLATION OF THE ORDINANCE IS A MUNICIPAL CIVIL INFRACTION. THE
- 19 ORDINANCE SHALL PROVIDE FOR A CIVIL FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00.
- 20 (4) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT A LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT,
- 21 OR OTHER PERSON, FROM APPLYING FOR A PERMIT UNDER SECTION 30104.
- 22 (5) THIS SECTION DOES NOT ALTER THE RIGHTS OF THE PUBLIC TO
- 23 USE LAWFULLY ACCESSIBLE INLAND LAKES AND STREAMS IN A MANNER
- 24 AUTHORIZED BY LAW.
