June 21, 2007, Introduced by Reps. Bieda, Condino and Warren and referred to the Committee on Tax Policy.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"

(MCL 436.1101 to 436.2303) by adding section 916a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 916A. (1) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 2 (A) "SMOKING" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 12905 OF
- 3 THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.12905.
- 4 (B) "SMOKING PERMIT" MEANS A PERMIT ISSUED TO A HOLDER OF AN
- 5 ON-PREMISES LICENSE THAT ALLOWS SMOKING ON THE LICENSED PREMISES.
- 6 (2) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY STATE LAW OR LOCAL ORDINANCE TO THE
- 7 CONTRARY, A LICENSEE THAT IS ISSUED A SMOKING PERMIT MAY ALLOW
- 8 SMOKING AND MAY ADVERTISE THE AVAILABILITY OF SMOKING ON THE
- 9 LICENSED PREMISES IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER ACTIVITIES ALLOWED ON
 - THE LICENSED PREMISES BY THIS ACT OR RULE ADOPTED UNDER THIS ACT.

- 1 (3) THE COMMISSION SHALL ISSUE A SMOKING PERMIT TO THE HOLDER
- 2 OF AN ON-PREMISES LICENSE WHO APPLIES TO THE COMMISSION AND PAYS
- 3 THE PERMIT FEE OF \$600.00. THE RENEWAL OF THE PERMIT SHALL BE
- 4 ACCOMPANIED BY A RENEWAL APPLICATION AND THE PERMIT FEE OF \$500.00.
- 5 (4) THE MONEY COLLECTED FOR THE INITIAL ISSUANCE AND RENEWAL
