

HOUSE BILL No. 5658

January 22, 2008, Introduced by Reps. Agema, Palmer, Pavlov, Calley, Meltzer, Elsenheimer, Knollenberg, Acciavatti, Stahl, Opsommer, Amos, Sheen, Booher, Nofs, Walker, Moolenaar, Steil, Brandenburg, Pastor, Pearce and Rick Jones and referred to the Committee on Oversight and Investigations.

A bill to amend 1972 PA 222, entitled

"An act to provide for an official personal identification card; to provide for its form, issuance and use; to regulate the use and disclosure of information obtained from the card; to prescribe the powers and duties of the secretary of state; to prescribe fees; to prescribe certain penalties for violations; and to provide an appropriation for certain purposes,"

(MCL 28.291 to 28.300) by adding section 5b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 5B. (1) IF A PERSON VIOLATES SECTION 543/ OF THE MICHIGAN
2 PENAL CODE, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.543/, AND THE VIOLATION IS A CAUSE
3 OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE'S IMPROPERLY ISSUING A STATE PERSONAL
4 IDENTIFICATION CARD TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS IN THIS COUNTRY
5 ILLEGALLY, THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE MAY RECOVER THE GREATER OF THE
6 FOLLOWING FROM THE PERSON OR FROM THE INDIVIDUAL WHO IS IN THIS

1 COUNTRY ILLEGALLY, OR BOTH:

2 (A) THE ACTUAL AND REASONABLE COSTS INCURRED BY THE DEPARTMENT
3 OF STATE AS A RESULT OF THE VIOLATION, INCLUDING CORRECTING THE
4 RECORDS OF THE DEPARTMENT.

5 (B) \$1,000.00.

6 (2) IF MORE THAN 1 PERSON OR INDIVIDUAL IS RESPONSIBLE FOR
7 PAYING COSTS UNDER THIS SECTION, THE COURT MAY ORDER THE AMOUNT
8 REQUIRED TO BE PAID UNDER THIS SECTION TO BE DIVIDED AMONG THOSE
9 PERSONS AND INDIVIDUALS.

10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
11 unless Senate Bill No. ____ or House Bill No. 5655 (request no.
12 05184'07) of the 94th Legislature is enacted into law.
