- 1 SEC. 12C. (1) IF A PERSON OR AGENCY THAT MAINTAINS A DATABASE
- 2 THAT INCLUDES PERSONAL IDENTIFYING INFORMATION REGARDING MULTIPLE
- 3 INDIVIDUALS SELLS OR OTHERWISE TRANSFERS ANY PERSONAL IDENTIFYING
- 4 INFORMATION CONCERNING A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE FROM THAT DATABASE
- 5 TO ANOTHER PERSON OR AGENCY, THE PERSON OR AGENCY TRANSFERRING THE
 - PERSONAL IDENTIFYING INFORMATION SHALL PROVIDE A NOTICE TO THAT
- 7 RESIDENT THAT INDICATES WHAT PERSONAL IDENTIFYING INFORMATION THE
- 8 PERSON OR AGENCY IS TRANSFERRING AND THE REASON FOR THE TRANSFER,
- 9 IDENTIFIES THE TRANSFEREE OF THAT INFORMATION, AND INCLUDES A

- 17 COMMUNICATIONS AND BASED ON THOSE COMMUNICATIONS THE PERSON OR
- 18 AGENCY REASONABLY BELIEVES THAT IT HAS THE RECIPIENT'S CURRENT
- 19 ELECTRONIC MAIL ADDRESS.
- 20 (iii) THE PERSON OR AGENCY CONDUCTS ITS BUSINESS PRIMARILY
- 21 THROUGH INTERNET ACCOUNT TRANSACTIONS OR ON THE INTERNET.
- 22 (C) IF NOT OTHERWISE PROHIBITED BY STATE OR FEDERAL LAW,
- 23 NOTICE GIVEN BY TELEPHONE BY AN INDIVIDUAL WHO REPRESENTS THE
- 24 PERSON OR AGENCY IF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING ARE MET:
- 25 (i) THE NOTICE IS NOT GIVEN IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY USE OF A
- 26 RECORDED MESSAGE.
- 27 (ii) THE RECIPIENT HAS EXPRESSLY CONSENTED TO RECEIVE NOTICE BY

- 1 TELEPHONE, OR IF THE RECIPIENT HAS NOT EXPRESSLY CONSENTED TO

- 6 BUSINESS DAYS AFTER THE INITIAL ATTEMPT TO PROVIDE TELEPHONIC

- 8 (3) A NOTICE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL MEET ALL OF THE
- 9 FOLLOWING:
- 10 (A) FOR A NOTICE PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (2) (A) OR (B), BE
- 11 WRITTEN IN A CLEAR AND CONSPICUOUS MANNER AND CONTAIN THE CONTENT
- 12 REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (2).
- 13 (B) FOR A NOTICE PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (2)(C), CLEARLY
- 14 COMMUNICATE THE CONTENT REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (2) TO THE
- 15 RECIPIENT OF THE TELEPHONE CALL.
- 16 (4) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (5), A PERSON THAT KNOWINGLY FAILS
- 17 TO PROVIDE ANY NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY BE ORDERED TO
- 18 PAY A CIVIL FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$250.00 FOR EACH FAILURE TO
- 19 PROVIDE NOTICE. THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OR A PROSECUTING ATTORNEY MAY
- 20 BRING AN ACTION TO RECOVER A CIVIL FINE UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 21 (5) THE AGGREGATE LIABILITY OF A PERSON FOR CIVIL FINES UNDER
- 22 SUBSECTION (4) FOR MULTIPLE VIOLATIONS OF SUBSECTION (4) THAT ARISE
- 23 FROM THE SAME TRANSFER OR INFORMATION SHALL NOT EXCEED \$750,000.00.
- 24 (6) SUBSECTIONS (3) AND (4) DO NOT AFFECT THE AVAILABILITY OF
- 25 ANY CIVIL REMEDY FOR A VIOLATION OF STATE OR FEDERAL LAW.
