A bill to amend 1957 PA 261, entitled

"Michigan legislative retirement system act,"

by amending section 50b (MCL 38.1050b), as amended by 1998 PA 501.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 50b. (1) For a retirant or a survivor or beneficiary of a
- 2 deceased retirant, or for a deferred vested member if that deferred
- 3 vested member first became a member on or before January 1, 1995,
- 4 the retirement system OFFICE OF RETIREMENT SERVICES IN THE
- 5 DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET shall SELECT, purchase, and pay
- 6 the premium for hospitalization and medical insurance coverage and
- 7 dental and vision coverage for the retirant, deferred vested
- 8 member, and the spouses, eligible children, and survivors of those
- 9 retirants and deferred vested members. Except as otherwise provided

- 1 in this section, the retirement system OFFICE OF RETIREMENT
- 2 SERVICES IN THE DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET shall provide
- 3 hospitalization and medical insurance coverage and dental and
- 4 vision insurance coverage under this section at a level that is
- 5 equal to or greater than the level of insurance coverage under this
- 6 section in effect on December 1, 1992. The OFFICE OF RETIREMENT
