November 19, 2008, Introduced by Rep. Tobocman and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled  
"The code of criminal procedure,"  
by amending section 16a of chapter XVII (MCL 777.16a), as amended  
by 2004 PA 216.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

### 1 CHAPTER XVII

2 Sec. 16a. This chapter applies to the following felonies  
3 enumerated in chapter 750 of the Michigan Compiled Laws:
