THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT: Sec. 9. (1) The state board of education EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN

SUBSECTION (2), THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION shall
regulate pupil transportation. The state board SUPERINTENDENT OF
PUBLIC INSTRUCTION or its HIS OR HER authorized representative may
review, confirm, set aside, or amend the action, order, or decision
of a school with reference to the routes over which pupils shall be
transported, and the suitability and number of the vehicles and
equipment for the transportation of the pupils. The superintendent

of public instruction shall promulgate rules as necessary to

- 2 cooperation with the superintendent of public instruction, may
- 3 promulgate rules related to vehicle and equipment standards.
