

SENATE BILL No. 675

August 1, 2007, Introduced by Senators KAHN, McMANUS, HARDIMAN, JANSEN and JELINEK and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make, supplement, and adjust appropriations for certain capital outlay projects for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2007; to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations; and to prescribe certain conditions for the appropriations.

20 PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

21 **GENERAL SECTIONS**

22 Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state
 23 constitution of 1963, total state spending under part 1 for the
 24 fiscal year ending September 30, 2007 is \$36,148,100.00. State
 25 payments to local units of government under this act are

1 \$21,392,700.00 as follows:

5 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and the expenditures
6 authorized under this act and the departments, agencies,
7 commissions, boards, offices, and programs for which an
8 appropriation is made under this act are subject to the management
9 and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594.

10 Sec. 203. The department of natural resources shall require
11 local units of government to enter into agreements with the
12 department of natural resources for the purpose of administering
13 the natural resources trust fund grants identified in part 1. Among
14 other provisions, the agreements shall require that grant
15 recipients agree to dedicate to public outdoor recreation uses in
16 perpetuity the land acquired or developed; to replace lands
17 converted or lost to other than public outdoor recreation use; and,
18 for parcels acquired that are over 5 acres in size, to provide the
19 state with a nonparticipating 1/6 minimum royalty interest in any
20 acquired minerals that are retained by the grant recipient. The
21 agreements shall also provide that the full payments of grants can
22 be made only after proof of acquisition, or completion of the
23 development project, is submitted by the grant recipient and all
24 costs are verified by the department of natural resources.

25 Sec. 204. Any unobligated balance in a natural resources trust
26 fund appropriation made under section 102 shall not revert to the
27 funds from which appropriated at the close of the fiscal year, but

1 shall continue until the purpose for which it was appropriated is
2 completed for a period not to exceed 3 fiscal years. The unexpended
3 balance of any natural resources trust fund appropriation made in
4 section 102 remaining after the purpose for which it was
5 appropriated is completed shall revert to the Michigan natural
6 resources trust fund and be made available for appropriation.
