

# SENATE BILL No. 742

September 6, 2007, Introduced by Senators HARDIMAN, ALLEN, GARCIA, RICHARDVILLE, BIRKHOLZ, PAPPAGEORGE, JELINEK, VAN WOERKOM, PATTERSON, CROUSEY, GILBERT, CASSIS, McMANUS, KUIPERS, OLSHOVE, JANSEN, SWITALSKI, STAMAS, CHERRY, BROWN, JACOBS, BARCIA, GLEASON, WHITMER, CLARKE, BISHOP, BASHAM, ANDERSON, SCHAUER, HUNTER, SCOTT and CLARK-COLEMAN and referred to the Committee on Senior Citizens and Veterans Affairs.

A bill to amend 1986 PA 288, entitled

"An act to establish a Michigan work-study program for qualified resident students attending eligible postsecondary schools and employed by qualified employers; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies,"

by amending section 3 (MCL 390.1373).

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 3. (1) A recognized postsecondary school in this state is  
2 eligible to participate in the MWS program if the postsecondary  
3 school **MEETS ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:**

4           **(A) THE SCHOOL** is a degree-granting institution approved by  
5 the state board of education. ~~the~~

6           **(B) THE** instructional programs are not comprised solely of

1 sectarian instruction or religious worship. ~~and the~~

2 (C) THE school participates in the federal work-study program  
3 under sections 441 to 448 of title IV of the higher education act  
4 of 1965, 42 U.S.C. ~~USC~~ 2751 to 2756b.

5 (D) THE SCHOOL CONSIDERS A STUDENT ENROLLED IN THAT SCHOOL A  
6 RESIDENT OF THIS STATE FOR DETERMINING HIS OR HER TUITION RATES IF  
7 THE STUDENT IS AN ACTIVE DUTY MEMBER, OR THE SPOUSE OR DEPENDENT  
8 CHILD OF AN ACTIVE DUTY MEMBER, OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED  
9 STATES, WHILE THAT ACTIVE DUTY MEMBER IS STATIONED IN THIS STATE  
10 AND DURING THE STUDENT'S CONTINUOUS FULL-TIME ENROLLMENT IN THE  
11 ACADEMIC DEGREE PROGRAM IN WHICH HE OR SHE IS ENROLLED IF THAT  
12 ACTIVE DUTY MEMBER IS TRANSFERRED TO ACTIVE DUTY OUTSIDE OF THIS  
13 STATE.

14 (2) A participating school, at its option, may offer academic  
15 credit to students enrolled in the MWS program.
