- 3 RENEWED IN THIS STATE AND A HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION
- 4 CONTRACT SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR THE TREATMENT OF AUTISM
- 5 SPECTRUM DISORDER, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, COVERAGE FOR
- 6 THERAPEUTIC EVALUATIONS AND INTERVENTIONS, SPEECH THERAPY,
- OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY, PHYSICAL THERAPY, INTENSIVE EARLY
- 8 INTERVENTION, APPLIED BEHAVIORAL ANALYSIS, AND LOVAAS BEHAVIORAL
- THERAPY.
