## **SENATE BILL No. 899**

November 8, 2007, Introduced by Senators KUIPERS, RICHARDVILLE, PAPPAGEORGE, BIRKHOLZ, GILBERT, KAHN, BROWN, GLEASON, JANSEN, VAN WOERKOM and HARDIMAN and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled
"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"
by amending section 72105a (MCL 324.72105a), as added by 1997 PA
129.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 72105a. (1) The department shall establish an "adopt-atrail" program that will allow volunteer groups to assist in maintaining and enhancing Michigan trailways and rail-trails.

- (2) Subject to subsection (3), volunteer groups in the adopta-trail program may adopt any available Michigan trailway or railtrail or Michigan trailway or rail-trail segment and may choose any 1 or more of the following volunteer activities:
  - (a) Spring cleanups.

- 1 (b) Environmental activities.
- 2 (c) Accessibility projects.
- 3 (d) Special events.
- 4 (e) Trailway maintenance and development.
- 5 (f) Public information and assistance.
- 6 (g) Training.
- 7 (3) The department shall designate the activities to be
- 8 performed by a volunteer group in the adopt-a-trail program. The
- 9 department may provide for more than 1 volunteer group to adopt a
- 10 Michigan trailway or rail-trail or Michigan trailway or rail-trail
- 11 segment.
- 12 (4) A volunteer group that wishes to participate in the adopt-
- 13 a-trail program shall submit an application to the department on a
- 14 form provided by the department. Additionally, THE volunteer groups
- 15 GROUP shall agree to ALL OF the following:
- 16 (a) Volunteer groups shall TO participate in the program for
- 17 at least a 2-year period.
- 18 (b) Volunteer groups shall TO consist of at least 6 people who
- 19 are 18 years of age or older, unless the volunteer group is a
- 20 school or scout organization, in which case the volunteers may be
- 21 under 18 years of age.
- 22 (c) Volunteer groups shall TO contribute a total of at least
- 23 400 service hours over a 2-year period.
- 24 (d) Volunteer groups shall—TO comply with other reasonable
- 25 requirements of the department.
- 26 (5) A state park manager or a district forest manager may
- 27 issue FREE CAMPING PERMITS to volunteers who are actively working

- 1 on adopt-a-trail projects that last more than 1 day, free camping
- 2 permits if campsites are available. A state park manager or a
- 3 district forest manager may waive state park entry fees for
- 4 volunteers entering state parks to work on adopt-a-trail projects.
- 5 (6) While a volunteer is working on an adopt-a-trail project,
- 6 the volunteer has the same immunity from civil liability as a
- 7 department employee and shall be treated in the same manner as an
- 8 employee under section 8 of 1964 PA 170, MCL 691.1408.
- 9 (7) The department shall design and erect ALONG OR near the
- 10 entrance of each Michigan trailway or rail-trail in the adopt-a-
- 11 trail program or along the trailway an adopt-a-trail program sign
- 12 with the name of the volunteer group's sponsoring organization
- 13 listed for each volunteer group that has contributed at least 100
- 14 service hours by volunteers.
- 15 (8) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE EACH VOLUNTEER GROUP
- 16 CONDUCTING CLEANUP ACTIVITY UNDER THIS SECTION WITH A METHOD FOR
- 17 THE VOLUNTEER GROUP TO RECORD THE TYPES AND AMOUNT OF TRASH
- 18 COLLECTED DURING THE GROUP'S CLEANUP ACTIVITY. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
- 19 REQUEST THAT THE INFORMATION BE FORWARDED TO THE DEPARTMENT UPON
- 20 COMPLETION. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE INFORMATION IT RECEIVES
- 21 UNDER THIS SUBSECTION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY.
- 22 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 23 unless Senate Bill No. 901
- of the 94th Legislature is enacted into law.
