

SENATE BILL No. 1060

January 24, 2008, Introduced by Senators PATTERSON, CHERRY, CLARK-COLEMAN, RICHARDVILLE, KAHN, HARDIMAN, BROWN, BASHAM, JELINEK, PAPPAGEORGE, JACOBS, BIRKHOLZ, OLSHOVE, PRUSI and SWITALSKI and referred to the Committee on Campaign and Election Oversight.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled
"Michigan election law,"
(MCL 168.1 to 168.992) by adding section 759e.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 759E. EACH CITY, TOWNSHIP, AND VILLAGE CLERK SHALL
2 MAINTAIN A PERMANENT ABSENT VOTER LIST. A QUALIFIED AND REGISTERED
3 ELECTOR MAY REQUEST TO BE PLACED ON THE PERMANENT ABSENT VOTER LIST
4 OF THE CITY, TOWNSHIP, OR VILLAGE IN WHICH THE ELECTOR IS
5 REGISTERED TO VOTE. A REQUEST BY AN ELECTOR UNDER THIS SECTION
6 SHALL BE MADE TO THE CITY, TOWNSHIP, OR VILLAGE CLERK IN PERSON, BY
7 TELEPHONE, FACSIMILE COMMUNICATION, OR FIRST-CLASS MAIL. THE CLERK
8 SHALL SEND TO EACH ELECTOR ON THE PERMANENT ABSENT VOTER LIST AN
9 APPLICATION FOR AN ABSENT VOTER BALLOT FOR EACH ELECTION.
