Overview

The School Aid budget makes appropriations to the state's 551 local school districts, 240 public school academies, and 57 intermediate school districts (ISDs) for operations and certain categorical programs. It also appropriates funds to the Center for Education Performance and Information, Department of Energy, Labor and Economic Growth, and other entities to implement certain grants and other programs related to K-12 education.

Major Budget Changes

1. FY 2009-10 Federal ARRA Maintenance of Effort (MOE)

Due to lower than anticipated special education costs and thus a related year-end lapse, it is currently estimated that the FY 2009-10 School Aid budget will fail to meet its required MOE for Federal ARRA grants. The currently estimated shortfall is between \$50 million and \$60 million.

Executive recommends that if at book-closing, the FY 2009-10 School Aid budget is determined to be less than the required Federal ARRA MOE, that an amount equal to that shortfall be appropriated on an equal per pupil basis to districts for the purposes of reducing the FY 2009-10 per pupil reduction (currently \$154) under Section 11d.

House concurs but would distribute the appropriation as follows:

- First, \$10.0 million to intermediate school districts (ISDs) in an amount equal to 14.75% of their FY 2009-10 allocations under Section 81.
- Second, the balance of the funds on an equal per pupil basis to districts to reduce the FY 2009-10 per pupil reduction under Section 11d.

From YTD****2. FY 2009-10 Proposed School Aid Transfer**

House implements executive school aid transfer by updating previous estimates related to special education hold harmless payment (Sec. 51a(3), special education millage equalization payment (Sec. 56) and the Proposal A portion of the foundation allowance (Sec. 22a), based on projected year end cost estimates. Funding is transferred from other special education accounts because of lower than anticipated reported costs and the cash flow borrowing costs because of lower interest rates.

While the foundation allowance costs in Sec. 22a are not yet finalized for year end, any additional funds not spent will lapse back to the school aid stabilization fund to be re-appropriated for the Federal ARRA MOE detailed above in item 1.

3. FY 2010-11 Federal Ed Jobs Funding

Executive recommends re-appropriating the \$246.0 million balance of the EdJobs funding, previously vetoed in HB 5872, under the 2x distribution formula. When added to the existing appropriation in HB 5872 (PA 205 of 2010), the current per pupil increases of \$23-\$46 will increase to a total of \$111 to \$222 per pupil depending on the district as determined under the 2x formula.

4. FY 2010-11 Per Pupil Reduction (Sec. 11d)

Executive recommends increasing the FY 2010-11 per pupil reduction under Section 11d from \$154 per pupil to \$170 per pupil in order to fund the *Adair v. State of Michigan* costs as described below under Section 152a. This would further reduce this line by a total of \$25.6 million.

House increases the FY 2010-11 per pupil reduction from \$154 to \$162 per pupil in order to fund nearly half of the *Adair v. State of Michigan* costs as described below under Section 152a. This would further reduce this line by a total of \$12.6 million.

5. Adair v. State of Michigan (Sec. 152a)

Executive recommends appropriating \$25.6 million to reimburse districts and ISDs for the costs of collecting, maintaining, and reporting data required by the State in response to the July 14, 2010 Opinion of the Michigan Supreme Court in *Adair v. State of Michigan* that such activities constitute an unfunded mandate under the Headlee Amendment of the State Constitution.
