OVERVIEW

House Bill 6153 contains \$1.7 million in restricted funds from the Commercial Mobile Radio Service Fees to match \$1.7 million in Federal Department of Transportation funds for a statewide 9-1-1 Internet Protocol (IP) mapping system. This bill would only take effect if House Bill 5622 was also enacted into law. House Bill 5622 allows \$1.7 million of the Commercial Mobile Radio Service Fees to be appropriated to the State Police budget for this purpose.

FY 2009-10 Appropriation Item:

STATE POLICE

1. Statewide 9-1-1 IP-Based Mapping System

Provides spending authority for restricted funds and federal funds to be used in the State Police budget for a 9-1-1 IP-based mapping system.
