## SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 794

(As amended, February 4, 2010)

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled "Revised judicature act of 1961,"

(MCL 600.101 to 600.9947) by adding section 1084.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1084. (1) A DWI/SOBRIETY COURT INTERLOCK PILOT PROJECT IS
- 2 CREATED UTILIZING THE DWI/SOBRIETY COURTS IN THIS STATE AND IN
- 3 ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER. THE DWI/SOBRIETY
- 4 COURT INTERLOCK PROJECT SHALL BEGIN ON JANUARY 1, 2011 AND SHALL
- 5 CONTINUE FOR A PERIOD OF 3 YEARS AFTER THAT DATE.
- 6 (2) ALL DWI/SOBRIETY COURTS THAT PARTICIPATE IN THE
- 7 DWI/SOBRIETY COURT INTERLOCK PILOT PROJECT SHALL COMPLY WITH THE 10
- 8 GUIDING PRINCIPLES OF DWI COURTS AS PROMULGATED BY THE NATIONAL
- 9 ASSOCIATION OF DRUG COURT PROFESSIONALS.
- 10 (3) IN ORDER TO BE CONSIDERED FOR PLACEMENT IN THE PILOT

- 1 VIOLATIONS OF SECTION 625(1) OR (3) OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE,
- 2 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.625.
- 3 (4) EACH YEAR, ALL DWI/SOBRIETY COURTS THAT PARTICIPATE IN THE
- 4 DWI/SOBRIETY COURT INTERLOCK PILOT PROJECT, IN COOPERATION WITH THE
- 5 STATE COURT ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE, SHALL PROVIDE TO THE
- 6 LEGISLATURE, THE SECRETARY OF STATE, AND THE SUPREME COURT
- 7 DOCUMENTATION AS TO PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS' COMPLIANCE WITH COURT
- 8 ORDERED CONDITIONS. BEST PRACTICES AVAILABLE SHALL BE USED IN THE
- 9 RESEARCH IN QUESTION, AS RESOURCES ALLOW, SO AS TO PROVIDE
- 10 STATISTICALLY RELIABLE DATA AS TO THE IMPACT OF THE PILOT PROJECT
- 11 ON PUBLIC SAFETY AND THE IMPROVEMENT OF LIFE CONDITIONS FOR PROGRAM
- 12 PARTICIPANTS. THE TOPICS DOCUMENTED SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE
- 13 LIMITED TO, ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 14 (A) THE PERCENTAGE OF THOSE PARTICIPANTS ORDERED TO PLACE
- 15 INTERLOCK DEVICES ON THEIR VEHICLES WHO ACTUALLY COMPLY WITH THE
- 16 ORDER.
- 17 (B) THE PERCENTAGE OF PARTICIPANTS WHO REMOVE COURT-ORDERED
- 18 INTERLOCKS FROM THEIR VEHICLES WITHOUT COURT APPROVAL.
- 19 (C) THE PERCENTAGE OF PARTICIPANTS WHO CONSUME ALCOHOL OR
- 20 CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES.
- 21 (D) THE PERCENTAGE OF PARTICIPANTS FOUND TO HAVE TAMPERED WITH
- 22 COURT-ORDERED INTERLOCKS.
- 23 (E) THE PERCENTAGE OF PARTICIPANTS WHO OPERATED A MOTOR
- 24 VEHICLE NOT EQUIPPED WITH AN INTERLOCK.
- 25 (F) RELEVANT TREATMENT INFORMATION AS TO PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS.
- 26 (G) THE PERCENTAGE OF PERSONS CONVICTED OF A NEW OFFENSE UNDER
- 27 SECTION 625(1) OR (3) OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300,

- 1 MCL 257.625.
- 2 (H) ANY OTHER INFORMATION FOUND TO BE RELEVANT.
- 3 (5) BEFORE THE SECRETARY OF STATE ISSUES A RESTRICTED LICENSE
- 4 TO A PARTICIPANT IN THE PILOT PROJECT UNDER SECTION 303 OF THE
- 5 MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.303, THE DWI/SOBRIETY
- 6 COURT JUDGE SHALL CERTIFY TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE THAT THE
- 7 INDIVIDUAL SEEKING THE RESTRICTED LICENSE HAS BEEN ADMITTED INTO
- 8 THE DWI/SOBRIETY COURT AND THAT AN INTERLOCK DEVICE HAS BEEN PLACED
- 9 ON EACH MOTOR VEHICLE OWNED OR OPERATED, OR BOTH, BY THE
- 10 INDIVIDUAL.
- 11 (6) IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING OCCUR, THE DWI/SOBRIETY COURT
- 12 JUDGE SHALL IMMEDIATELY INFORM THE SECRETARY OF STATE OF THAT
- 13 OCCURRENCE:
- 14 (A) A PROGRAM PARTICIPANT IS TERMINATED FROM THE DWI/SOBRIETY
- 15 COURT PROGRAM.
- 16 (B) THE COURT BECOMES AWARE THAT A PROGRAM PARTICIPANT
- 17 OPERATES A MOTOR VEHICLE THAT IS NOT EQUIPPED WITH AN INTERLOCK
- 18 DEVICE OR THAT A PROGRAM PARTICIPANT TAMPERS WITH OR REMOVES A
- 19 COURT-ORDERED INTERLOCK DEVICE WITHOUT PRIOR COURT APPROVAL.
- 20 (C) A PROGRAM PARTICIPANT IS CHARGED WITH A NEW VIOLATION OF
- 21 SECTION 625(1) OR (3) OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300,
- 22 MCL 257.625.
- 23 (7) THE RECEIPT OF NOTIFICATION BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE
- 24 UNDER SUBSECTION (6) SHALL RESULT IN SUMMARY REVOCATION OF THE
- 25 RESTRICTED LICENSE UNDER SECTION 303 OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE,
- 26 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.303, OR SUSPENSION OF THE RESTRICTED LICENSE
- 27 UNDER SECTION 319 OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL

- 257.319, AS APPLICABLE. 1
- 2 (8) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "DWI/SOBRIETY COURTS" MEANS THE
- 3 SPECIALIZED COURT PROGRAMS ESTABLISHED WITHIN JUDICIAL CIRCUITS AND
- DISTRICTS THROUGHOUT THIS STATE THAT ARE DESIGNED TO REDUCE
- 5 RECIDIVISM AMONG ALCOHOL OFFENDERS AND THAT COMPLY WITH THE 10
- GUIDING PRINCIPLES OF DWI COURTS AS PROMULGATED BY THE NATIONAL
- ASSOCIATION OF DRUG COURT PROFESSIONALS. 7
- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect 8
- 9 unless Senate Bill No. 795 of the 95th Legislature is enacted into
- 10 law.
