## **HOUSE BILL No. 4082**

January 22, 2009, Introduced by Reps. Rogers and Paul Scott and referred to the Committee on Ethics and Elections.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled

"Michigan election law,"

by amending section 737a (MCL 168.737a), as amended by 2006 PA 87.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 737a. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section,
- 2 the board of election inspectors shall not count a write-in vote
- 3 for a person unless that person has filed a declaration of intent
- 4 to be a write-in candidate as provided in this section. The write-
- 5 in candidate shall file the declaration of intent to be a write-in
- 6 candidate with the filing official for that elective office on or
- 7 before 4 p.m. on the second Friday immediately before the election.
  - The secretary of state, immediately after the 4 p.m. filing
  - deadline under this subsection, shall prepare and have delivered a

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- 1 list of all persons who have filed a declaration of intent to be a
- 2 write-in candidate under this subsection, if any, to the
- 3 appropriate county clerks. A filing official other than the
- 4 secretary of state who receives a declaration of intent to be a
- 5 write-in candidate or list of persons who filed a declaration of
- 6 intent from another filing official under this subsection shall
- 7 prepare and have delivered a list of all persons who have filed a
- 8 declaration of intent to be a write-in candidate to the board of
- 9 election inspectors in the appropriate precincts before the close
- 10 of the polls on election day.
- 11 (2) If a candidate whose name is printed on the official
- 12 ballot for the election dies or is otherwise disqualified on or
- 13 after the Wednesday immediately before the election, the
- 14 requirement of filing a declaration of intent to be a write-in
- 15 candidate under subsection (1) does not apply to a write-in
- 16 candidate. If a death or disqualification has occurred as described
- 17 in this subsection, the board of election inspectors shall count
- 18 all write-in votes for write-in candidates for the office sought by
- 19 the deceased or disqualified candidate.
- 20 (3) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION, A
- 21 CANDIDATE FOR AN OFFICE WHOSE NAME IS PRINTED ON A PRIMARY ELECTION
- 22 BALLOT AND WHO LOSES THE PRIMARY ELECTION SHALL NOT BE ELIGIBLE TO
- 23 FILE A DECLARATION OF INTENT TO BE A WRITE-IN CANDIDATE FOR THAT
- 24 SAME OFFICE AT THE GENERAL ELECTION. THIS PROHIBITION DOES NOT
- 25 APPLY IF A CANDIDATE WHOSE NAME IS PRINTED ON THE GENERAL ELECTION
- 26 BALLOT FOR THAT OFFICE DIES OR IS OTHERWISE DISQUALIFIED BEFORE THE
- 27 GENERAL ELECTION.

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- 1 (4) (3)—Subsections (1) and (2) do not apply to a write-in
- 2 candidate for precinct delegate. The board of election inspectors
- 3 shall not count a write-in vote for a write-in candidate for
- 4 precinct delegate unless that candidate has filed a declaration of
- 5 intent to be a write-in candidate as provided in this subsection. A
- 6 write-in candidate for precinct delegate shall file a declaration
- 7 of intent to be a write-in candidate with the appropriate city or
- 8 township clerk for that precinct on or before 4 p.m. on the Friday
- 9 immediately before the election or with the board of election
- 10 inspectors in the appropriate precinct before the close of the
- 11 polls on election day. A city or township clerk who receives a
- 12 declaration of intent to be a write-in candidate from a write-in
- 13 candidate for precinct delegate under this subsection shall prepare
- 14 and have delivered a list of all persons who have filed a
- 15 declaration of intent to be a write-in candidate to the board of
- 16 election inspectors in the appropriate precincts before the close
- 17 of the polls on election day.
- 18 (5) (4)—The secretary of state shall prescribe forms for the
- 19 declaration of intent to be a write-in candidate. Clerks shall
- 20 maintain a supply of declaration of intent to be a write-in
- 21 candidate forms in the clerk's office and make the forms available
- 22 in the polling places during the August primary for this purpose.
- 23 The declaration of intent to be a write-in candidate form shall
- 24 include all of the following information:
- 25 (a) The name of the person intending to be a write-in
- 26 candidate.
- 27 (b) The elective office that the person seeks as a write-in

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- 1 candidate.
- 2 (c) The residence address of the person seeking elective
- 3 office as a write-in candidate.
- 4 (d) Other information the secretary of state considers
- 5 appropriate.
