## **HOUSE BILL No. 4579**

March 12, 2009, Introduced by Reps. Warren, Leland, Hansen, Terry Brown, Scripps, Lipton, Liss, Young, Tlaib, Durhal, Meadows and Miller and referred to the Committee on Great Lakes and Environment.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 41301 (MCL 324.41301), as amended by 2005 PA 77.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 41301. (1) As used in this part:
- (a) "Council" means the invasive species advisory councilcreated in section 41321.
  - (b) "Department" means the department of natural resources.
  - (c) "Genetically engineered" refers to an organism whose genome, chromosomal or extrachromosomal, is modified permanently and heritably, using recombinant nucleic acid techniques, or the

- 1 progeny thereof OF SUCH AN ORGANISM.
- 2 (d) "Introduce", with reference to an organism, means to
- 3 knowingly and willfully stock, place, plant, release, or allow the
- 4 release of the organism in this state at any specific location
- 5 where the organism is not already naturalized.
- 6 (e) "Prohibited aquatic plant species" means any of the
- 7 following or fragments or seeds thereof SPECIES" MEANS ANY OF THE
- 8 FOLLOWING:
- 9 (i) ANY OF THE FOLLOWING PROHIBITED AQUATIC PLANT SPECIES,
- 10 INCLUDING A HYBRID OR GENETICALLY ENGINEERED VARIANT OF THE SPECIES
- 11 OR A FRAGMENT OR SEED OF THE SPECIES OR OF A HYBRID OR GENETICALLY
- 12 ENGINEERED VARIANT:
- (A) (i)—African oxygen weed (Lagarosiphon major). or a hybrid
- 14 or genetically engineered variant thereof.
- 15 (B) (ii)—Brazilian elodea (Egeria densa). or a hybrid or
- 16 genetically engineered variant thereof.

- 14 COLLARED DOVE (STREPTOPELIA DECAOCTO).
- 15 (iii) THE FOLLOWING PROHIBITED CRUSTACEAN SPECIES, INCLUDING A
- 16 HYBRID OR GENETICALLY ENGINEERED VARIANT OF THE SPECIES OR AN EGG
- 17 OF THE SPECIES OR OF A HYBRID OR GENETICALLY ENGINEERED VARIANT:
- 18 RUSTY CRAYFISH (ORCONECTES RUSTICUS).

- 20 ( $\nu$ ) ANY OF THE FOLLOWING PROHIBITED INSECT SPECIES, INCLUDING
- 21 A HYBRID OR GENETICALLY ENGINEERED VARIANT OF THE SPECIES OR AN EGG
- 22 OF THE SPECIES OR OF A HYBRID OR GENETICALLY ENGINEERED VARIANT:
- 23 (A) (i)—Asian longhorned beetle (Anoplophora glabripennis). ex
- 24 a hybrid or genetically engineered variant thereof.

- (F) (i) "Recombinant nucleic acid techniques" means laboratory
- 14 techniques through which genetic material is isolated and
- 15 manipulated in vitro and then inserted into an organism.
- 16 (G) (j) "Restricted aquatic plant species" means any of the
- 17 following or fragments or seeds thereof SPECIES" MEANS ANY OF THE
- 18 FOLLOWING:
- 19 (i) ANY OF THE FOLLOWING RESTRICTED AQUATIC PLANT SPECIES,
- 20 INCLUDING A HYBRID OR GENETICALLY ENGINEERED VARIANT OF THE SPECIES
- 21 OR A FRAGMENT OR SEED OF THE SPECIES OR OF A HYBRID OR GENETICALLY
- 22 ENGINEERED VARIANT:
- 23 (A) (i)—Curly leaf pondweed (Potamogeton crispus). or a hybrid
- 24 or genetically engineered variant thereof.
- 25 (B)  $\frac{(ii)}{(ii)}$  Eurasian watermilfoil (Myriophyllum spicatum). or a
- 26 hybrid or genetically engineered variant thereof.
- 27 (C) (iii) Flowering rush (Butomus umbellatus). or a hybrid or

- 1 genetically engineered variant thereof.
- 2 (D)  $\frac{(iv)}{(iv)}$  Phragmites or common reed (Phragmites australis). or a
- 3 hybrid or genetically engineered variant thereof.
- 4 (E) (v) Purple loosestrife (Lythrum salicaria), or a hybrid or
- 5 genetically engineered variant thereof, except for THAT cultivars
- 6 OF PURPLE LOOSESTRIFE developed and recognized to be sterile and
- 7 approved by the director of **THE DEPARTMENT OF** agriculture under
- 8 section 16a of the insect pest and plant disease act, 1931 PA 189,
- 9 MCL 286.216a, ARE NOT A RESTRICTED SPECIES.
- 10 (k) "Restricted species" means a restricted aquatic plant
- 11 species.
- 12 (ii) ANY OF THE FOLLOWING RESTRICTED MOLLUSK SPECIES, INCLUDING
- 13 A HYBRID OR GENETICALLY ENGINEERED VARIANT OF THE SPECIES OR AN EGG
- 14 OF THE SPECIES OR OF A HYBRID OR GENETICALLY ENGINEERED VARIANT:
- 15 (A) QUAGGA MUSSEL (DREISSENA BUGENSIS).
- 16 (B) ZEBRA MUSSEL (DREISSENA POLYMORPHA).
- 17 (2) For the purposes of this part:
- 18 (a) A person is not considered to possess a live organism
- 19 simply because the organism is present on land or in waters owned
- 20 by that person unless the person has knowingly introduced that live
- 21 organism on that land or in those waters.
- 22 (b) A person is not considered to possess a live organism if
- 23 the organism was obtained from the environment and the person only
- 24 possesses the organism at the specific location at which it was
- 25 obtained from the environment.
- (c) A person is not considered to possess a live organism if
- 27 the possession is for the purpose of promptly destroying the
