- 2 exemplary damages of not more than \$500.00 \$2,500.00 total, plus

- 5 (2) Not more than 1 action under this section shall be brought
- 6 against a public official for a single meeting. An action under
- 7 this section shall be commenced within 180 days after the date of
- 8 the violation which THAT gives rise to the cause of action.

- 10 with an action for injunctive or exemplary relief under section 11.
