## **HOUSE BILL No. 4798**

April 2, 2009, Introduced by Reps. Sheltrown, Polidori and Mayes and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled

"Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"

by amending section 513 (MCL 436.1513), as amended by 2007 PA 11.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 513. (1) The commission may issue to the governing board
- 2 of a college or university, without regard to the quota provisions
- 3 of section 531, a license to sell alcoholic liquor for consumption
- 4 on the premises of a conference center operated by the governing
- 5 board. Licenses granted under this subsection may be used only for
- 6 the sale of alcoholic liquor at regularly scheduled conference
- 7 center activities. The sale of alcoholic liquor to unscheduled
  - patrons or at unscheduled events is prohibited under this
- subsection.
  - (2) Subject to the provisions of section 531, the commission may issue a license to a private entity for the sale of alcoholic

- 1 liquor for consumption on the premises of a hotel located on land
- 2 owned by central Michigan university if both of the following
- 3 circumstances exist:
- 4 (a) The land is leased or subleased at fair market value to a

- 7 (b) The hotel and land are located within an industrial,
