October 13, 2009, Introduced by Reps. Slezak, Haase, Haugh, Liss, Kennedy, Neumann, Roy Schmidt, Polidori, Corriveau, Leland, Nathan, Durhal, Geiss and DeShazor and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code," by amending section 1147 (MCL 380.1147).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1147. (1) A person, resident of a school district not
 maintaining CHILD WHO RESIDES IN A SCHOOL DISTRICT THAT DOES NOT
 PROVIDE a kindergarten and WHO IS at least 5 years of age on the
 first day of enrollment of the school year , shall have a right to
 MAY attend school in the district.
 - (2) In EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION, IN a school district where provision is made for kindergarten work THAT PROVIDES KINDERGARTEN, a child , resident of WHO RESIDES IN the SCHOOL district , is entitled to MAY enroll in the kindergarten if

- 13 entitled to MAY enroll in kindergarten for the second semester if
- 14 the child is at least 5 years of age on March 1 of the year of
